

Nebušice Cemetery

This will be an investigation of how and if a sample population can be used to give a statistical representation of an area's larger population. We are going to collect data individually in a cemetery in the nearby village of Nebušice, making note of the name of the person buried, birth date, and the date of death. If you have ethical or moral issues with being able to perform this, please let me know beforehand.

After everyone has collected "**sufficient**" data, we will bring it back to the classroom and type it up (digitize it) in a table of your own creation. It is up to you to analyze this data, assuming names will indicate gender according to typical Czech grammar (e.g., surnames ending in *-ova* and *-a* are female).

You must develop a focused research question to further analyze your data, but some general ideas are:

- average lifespan(s)
- female/male comparison(s)
- the typical Nebušice villager more/less than typical Czech comparison(s)
- historical significance (WWII)
- decade comparison(s)
