### **Aim 1 - Knowledge Equity**

Increase the engagement and representation of marginalised people and subjects,

### Progress:

Towards the end of October, Leeds Library suggested hosting a wiki editathon centred around This edit-a-thon will focus on traditionally underrepresented and marginalised voices in contemporary comics and graphic novels, exploring the representation of Black, Asian and minority ethnic, disabled and LGBTQ+ comics creators and characters. The editathon will be advertised on Eventbrite to encourage a diverse and wide range of people to come to the session. The event will be held on the 11<sup>th</sup> of November at Leeds central library. I will be there to offer any support to participants and to contribute to the event.
