3. School Administration Update

Monsieur Daniel's updates:

Thank you to the PAC for inviting us to the meeting.

- Thanks to the returning PAC members and welcome to the new members.
- We have 20 divisions and 465 students for the new school year. 60 children in late french immersion. English teacher Mr. Fleming has left the school and Mrs. Pond/Ryan is the new English Grade 1 teacher. One teacher has returned full time after mat leave. New PE teacher on 3 days, Tues-Weds, Madame Leisure is teaching Grade 3, Ms. Neighbour is the 5-6 teacher. Madame Sofia is teaching for 2 days and we are still looking for a teacher for French immersion for the other 3 days. Temporary opening in Kindergarten as well. We have a new person in the office, Monday and Wednesday.
- Thank you for your patience and understanding for allowing time for the children to get to their new classrooms. A major reason behind this is because in our catchment, we had 30 students we had to place in other schools. 40 students were on the waitlist in our catchment not including crossboundary. We had to ensure all students had a place. There are still some schools who have not placed their students as of yet.. Thank you to all of those in the different organisations.
- Parents interested in being class parents, contact your teacher.
- If you look today in your child's backpack you will find some important forms. You can submit some online. Please reach out if you need help.
- I would also like to talk about the school fees. Justine has already put out the information in an email. If you know any families that need help with these fees please contact me. We will work with the PAC to help the families not have any financial burdens.
- Cross country is to start next week. There is a new policy for jerseys. We will send
 home a form that has to be completed by the family. This form will make sure that the
 jersey's are returned. There will be a fee for the jersey's as well. Thank you to the
 PAC for helping with the new jersey's for the teams for the school year.
- We will be having our assembly about kindness as this is a very important topic in our school.
- The ministry has said no more digital devices in the school. Children can bring them to school but not use them within the school. If a parent needs to communicate with their child they are to call the office. Students will not be able to use the phone in the classroom. There are many reasons behind this, we can not control all students as they take photos and there is a privacy policy behind this. First time we catch a student with the phone it will be taken away. There will be further actions taken with further offences.
- Grade 7's will start meetings with teachers soon. We will not forget about graduation, camp, and field trips.
- Welcome to the kindergarten families.
- There will be a great day with a full day tomorrow. We will support within the classroom and staff around the school.

Madame Katrina's updates:

- Hello my name is Madame Katrina. I am the vice principal. Welcome back.
- We had our first assembly today. We went over the school code of conduct, VSB school code of conduct, school boundaries, new members of staff, and supervision aids. Children can go to the aids or the principals for any questions or concerns. With the code of conduct, we are Spirit Wolves so we howl. We are open minded and open to new ideas. Everything we do revolves around the howl and school rules have been highlighted.

- Next Friday we will have our kindness assembly. Parents unfortunately will not be able to attend due to space but we will take pictures and have them on the newsletter.



<u>9.</u> <u>Band</u>

Jennifer:

We are very happy that the Trafalgar School Band will be running again this year, beginning in October. Registration is open now.

For those of you that don't know, the Trafalgar School Band is an extracurricular music program organised by parents, as the VSB no longer funds this kind of program in elementary schools. Our band instructors are both professional musicians who are really amazing with kids and make music and learning an instrument fun.

Trafalgar students who are in Grade 4-7 are eligible to play in the band. Junior, or beginning band, is open to any student who is interested in learning how to play an instrument, absolutely no experience required. Senior band is for students who have already completed junior band or have previous experience with one of the band instruments. Practices run before school, twice per week, for the entire school year. The band usually performs a few concerts at the school throughout the year, and competes at the Kiwanis Music Festival.

Registration is open now, info is in the school newsletter and Mr Grimm is letting kids know when he sees them in music class.

Some questions might be:

What instruments. Band students get to choose from a wide variety of woodwind and bass instruments - they can choose flute, clarinet, trumpet, trombone, baritone, oboe, and senior band students can try the French horn.

When: The senior band meets every Wednesday and Thursday from 7:45 to 8:45 am and the junior/beginning band meets every Tuesday and Thursday from 7:45 to 8:45 am during the school year. (Please note Thursday is a combined rehearsal where beginning band gets to play with senior band together.)

Where: The rehearsal will take place in the Activity Room.

Cost: The band is paid for by families and is based on the number of students enrolled. Last year the cost was \$485 - this covered practices, twice per week, for the school year. The fee cover the instructors fee, insurance, and room rental. Renting an instrument is also required.
