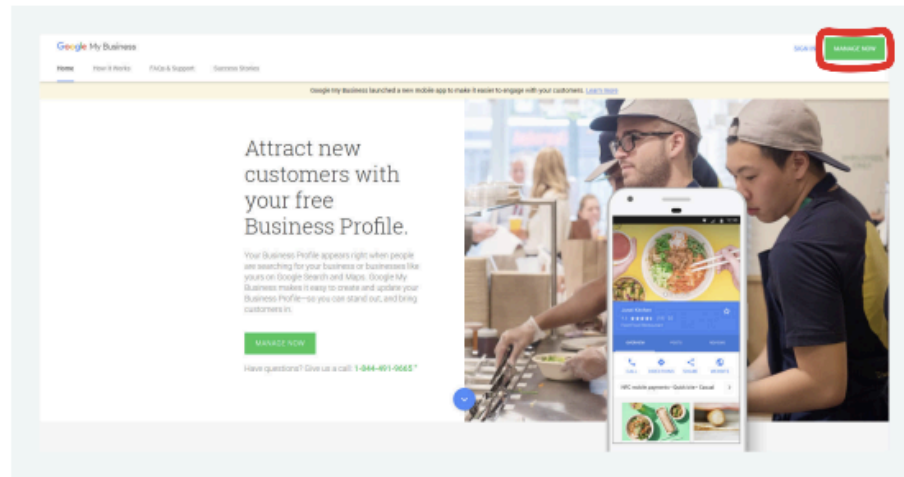


Figure 6.1 - Navigate to Google My Business (GMB).

In my experience, Google picks up new structured data relatively quickly, that is to say in less than 24 hours.

What I have detailed above is a manual solution for adding structured data, which I find ideal for SEO professionals who want to understand different schema types and properties available to enhance the chosen entity.

When you're ready to adopt a more scalable approach, you can use **Google Tag Manager** to build a template and have your web developer set up some variables to extract data like the following example."
