RESEARCH PROFILE

I have published in the areas of MR physics, MR safety, and patient safety.

We described a simple technique to mitigate the artifact on spine MRI caused by pedicle screws (used for fusion procedures.)

Regarding MR safety, I noticed that prior publications had incorrectly described the point of maximum attractive force and the maximal attractive force was up to 70-80 % higher than the force measured at the previously accepted location. This could affect the determination of whether implants are deemed safe or not.

Regarding patient safety, we did a survey of training programs and noted that half of fellowship programs were not following CDC guidelines for wearing facemasks during myelography. I served on the ACR Practice Parameter and Technical Standards Committee was able to get this added to the [2024 ACR Practice Parameter for Myelography](#).

CLINICAL PROFILE

I am a clinical neuroradiologist. I was in the first cohort to take the ABR CAQ exam in 1995. I served as an item writer for the American Board of Radiology (ABR) Ongoing Longitudinal Assessment (OLA) exam.

I introduced the use of pencil point needles for lumbar punctures performed by radiologists at MSM and MSW.

I have advocated for removing ionic contrast from formularies in order to reduce the possibility of fatal medication errors.

Since I have interventional neuroradiology experience, I have a special interest in stroke and vascular lesions. I can also perform C1-2 punctures.

MENTORING PROFILE

I have mentored many students, residents, and colleagues. I would like to highlight the 1st place Award of ISMMS student Iris Chen '18 at the AUR meeting in 2018, as well the 1996 RSNA Research Trainee Prize for neuroradiology with former resident Vincent Frazzini. I have used social media and other networking to help others, especially those who are under-represented in medicine. I spoke at a regional SNMA meeting regarding how to interview for residency. One of my tips was even included by a Stanford faculty in a

presentation at RSNA 2019. I recently advocated for two of our residents, who got their first choice fellowships at Stanford. My recent experience with ombuds training and MBSR training have made me a better mentor.

OVERALL IMPACT

I was a residency program director for 15 years, training about 100 residents. It is gratifying to see them become successful. We achieved a 100% 5-yr oral board and later a 100% core exam pass rate while I was PD.

I have been involved in Quality and Safety at a local and national level. I co-moderated a 4 hour session at the 2019 ACR Quality and Safety meeting. I spoke about patient safety at a recent San Diego Radiology Society meeting.

I've been invited to speak/moderate at national and international meetings such as RSNA, AUR, ARRS, ACR Intersociety Committee (ISC) Meeting, ACR Quality and Safety, and ASER.

In addition to multiple presentations at national radiology meetings, I have been invited to speak at UCSD, MGH, Northwestern, Johns Hopkins, and Emory as well. I was invited to speak at the NHS Education for Scotland (NES) meeting and the virtual Association for Medical Education in Europe (AMEE) meeting in Scotland.
