Principal's Pen

Thank you to the many families and community at large for supporting our **Arts Fundraiser** last Friday. The dinner, auction, and entertainment were excellent. Big thanks to our PTA, the Marks Family, and to Joshua Homme for making it happen. The PTA will report out on our earnings very soon. I think it's safe to say that we will have arts education from Ms. Nicole Fisher not only from January to June but for all of next year too!

Reminder: On the 17th students will hold a live **Holiday Show** for registered visitors. They will be wearing snowman, elf, and penguin costumes! To attend the Friday, December 17th Holiday Shows, parents must "purchase" a free ticket. Limited tickets will be "sold" 72 to 48 hours in advance. (Tickets go on sale Tuesday, December 14th.) This <u>Holiday Show Google Survey</u> will be used by parents to get their name on the "Will Call" list and to upload either their Covid-19 Vaccination or Proof of Negative Covid-19 PCR. (The Negative Covid-19 PCR must be dated within the last 72 hours.) You may bring a physical copy with you to the Will Call gate. The survey will serve as our Guest List/Will Call. Parents may purchase tickets to both shows. Required masks will be available upon arrival. Please carpool and watch for parking restrictions. Please arrive early.

Last week we <u>again</u> had **no positive Covid tests**. (We screen every Tuesday at school.) As always, if you or your child has symptoms of Covid, do not come to campus, inform our health aide and nurse, and get tested.

We remain steadfast in protecting our school community and are so relieved when we get good reports. Please see the Parent Resource box below for more details on how we are **taking extra steps** to keep the pandemic from closing down our school and to keep everyone healthy. Please check your email daily, including each night and each morning before coming to school, to see if a positive COVID-19 case has been identified in your child's class and if your child needs to follow the quarantine protocols. Sometimes we are informed of a positive case late at night, and we need to inform multiple families as quickly as possible that their child needs to be quarantined. If a positive case is identified in your child's class, please know that district nursing staff will follow up with you as part of contact tracing. If you have specific questions please email me directly. I am glad to help.

Speedier and Easier Student Departure Procedure

Thank you to our SSC for revising our "Safe Arrival and Departure Plan" and to our PTA for creating the placards for everyone. Soon laminated student name placards will be sent home to parents / guardians. The highly visible name tags will support faster and safer student pick up at the end of the school day. Place the placard on your dash or flip it over your visor.

All of the names are numbered. That way staff have the option of saying a number or the name. Students will need to know their number, parents can share this info with students; as parents will have the placards with the number/name. Each family has a number. For example: two students from the same family will have the same number. That way when you pull up to the car line, staff can say, "##" or "Last Name" and both of your children will come to the pick up spot.

Family tags have just the last name.

Next year's incoming Kindergartners - if they are a new family, they will have a new number. If they have an older sibling, they will share that number; so each family has one car pick up number.

Independent Study - Clarifications

Independent Study is appropriate for Emergencies, catastrophic family situations, legal/government situations, severe health or other special circumstances. Independent Study is NOT for extending the length of school holidays, vacations or visiting family or friends.

The school must be informed in advance (we realize this isn't always possible in an Emergency). A contract needs to be filled out and signed by the parent, teacher and Principal. If work is not turned in or is not complete, partial credit or no credit may be given.
