Pass Responsibilities

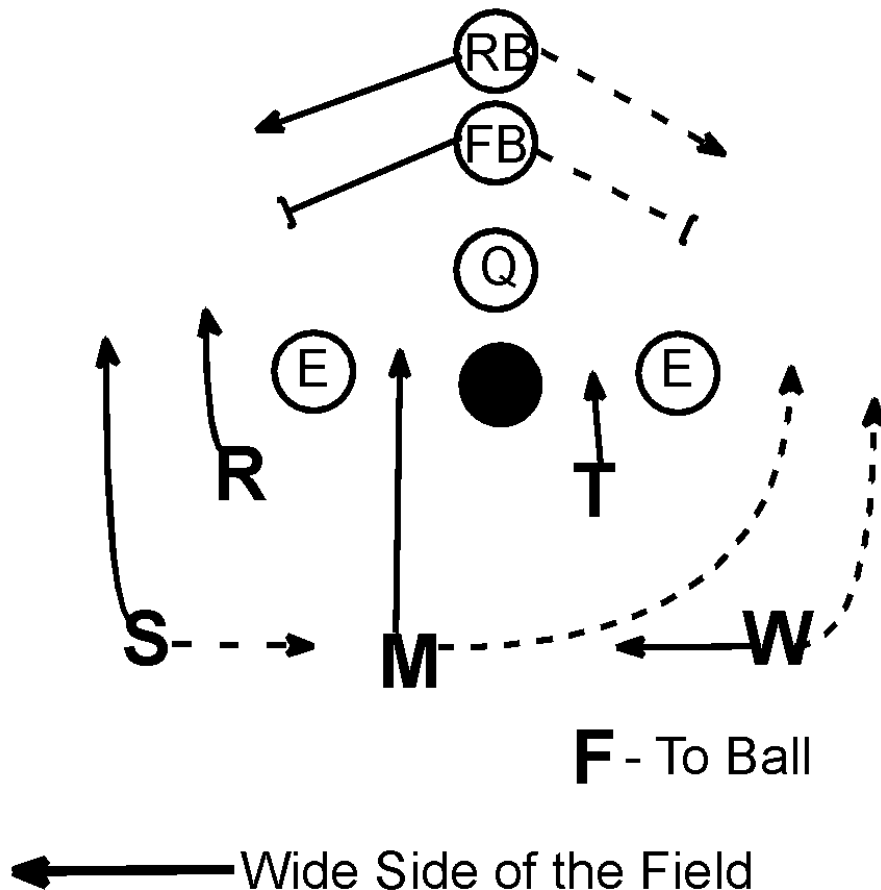
F – First Receiver Out of the Backfield

M – Second Receiver Out of the Backfield

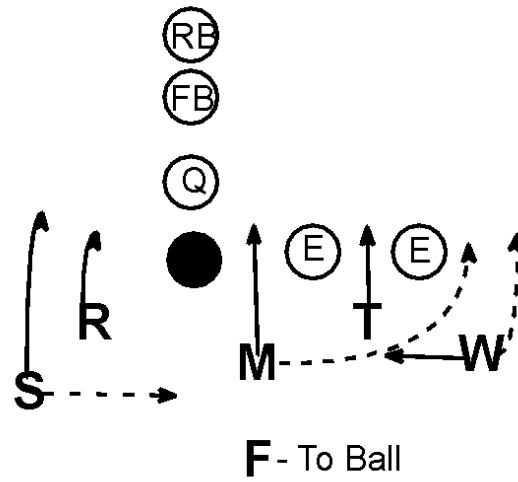
S and W – Spy End to Side, Add to Rush if End Stays in to Block

2-3 vs Overload Formations



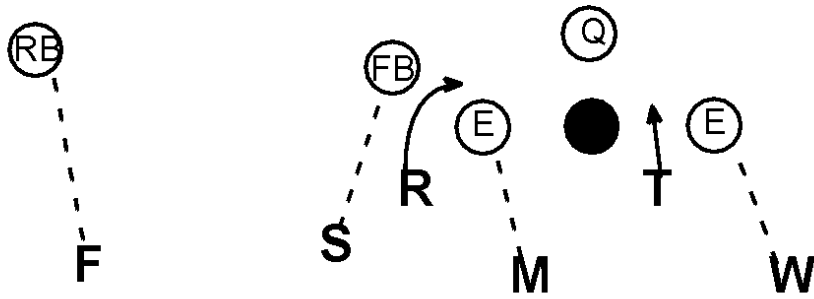
2-3 vs Ace Slot Right/Left

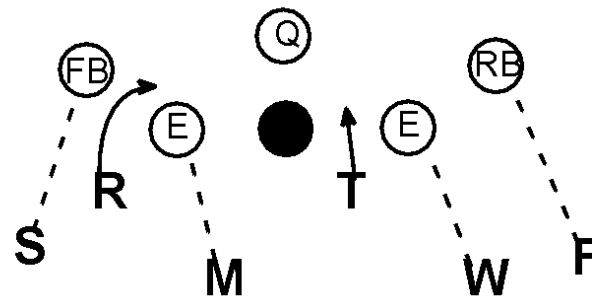
2-3 vs Twin Wide Right

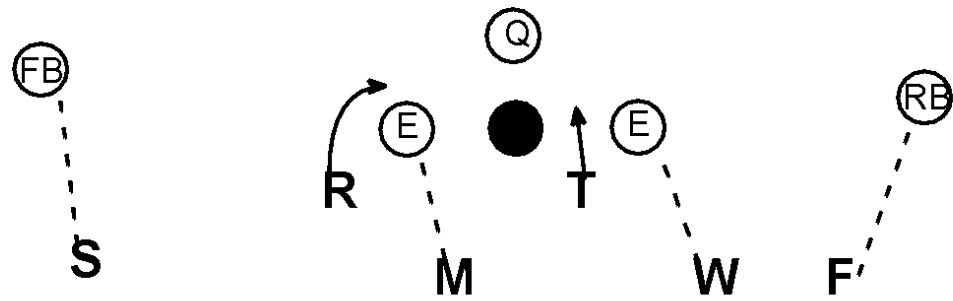
2-3 vs Wide Right/Left Slot Right/Left



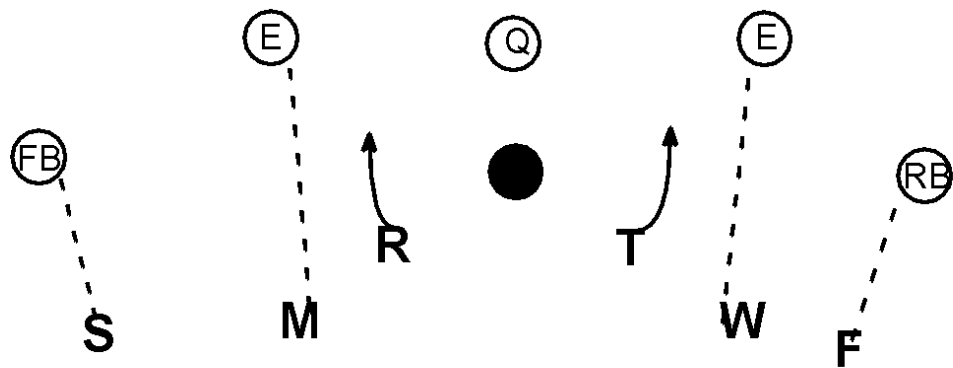
2-3 vs Double Slot

2-3 (Cover 3 Zone) vs Spread Formations
