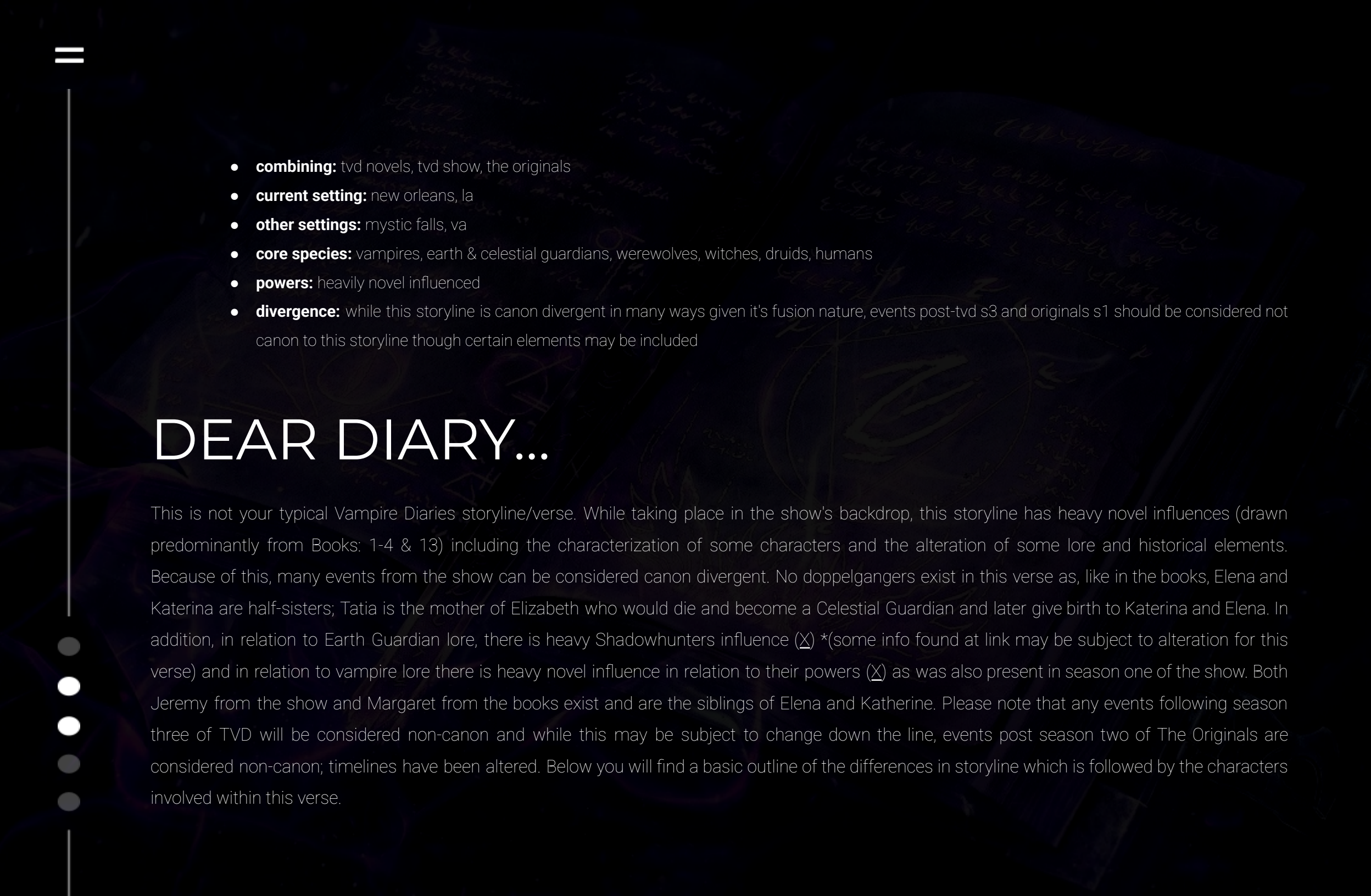

DEAR DIARY...

This is not your typical Vampire Diaries storyline/verse. While taking place in the show's backdrop, this storyline has heavy novel influences (drawn predominantly from Books: 1-4 & 13) including the characterization of some characters and the alteration of some lore and historical elements. Because of this, many events from the show can be considered canon divergent. No doppelgangers exist in this verse as, like in the books, Elena and Katerina are half-sisters; Tatia is the mother of Elizabeth who would die and become a Celestial Guardian and later give birth to Katerina and Elena. In addition, in relation to Earth Guardian lore, there is heavy Shadowhunters influence (X) *(some info found at link may be subject to alteration for this verse) and in relation to vampire lore there is heavy novel influence in relation to their powers (X) as was also present in season one of the show. Both Jeremy from the show and Margaret from the books exist and are the siblings of Elena and Katherine. Please note that any events following season three of TVD will be considered non-canon and while this may be subject to change down the line, events post season two of The Originals are considered non-canon; timelines have been altered. Below you will find a basic outline of the differences in storyline which is followed by the characters involved within this verse.

ALTERED ORIGINS

In the dawn of time a celestial court of angels was formed, their enemy the Phantoms whom they imprisoned, after a large conflict, in their realm, the Dark Dimension's moon. Thousands of years later, a powerful witch, Esther-- who had made a deal with her sister which forced her to give up one of her children--, seeking to protect her family from the wolves who had roamed the Earth since all could remember had performed a powerful ritual, using the blood of Tatia, of which would turn her children into the first Vampires. These events upset the balance and threatened the Celestial Court's power causing a chain reaction of events of which the court held no power to change.

Five hundred years ago, a Guardian who was the daughter of Tatia and became an angel after her death, defected, choosing to live among mortals, and had a child, Katerina Petrova, who would later adopt the name Katherine Sivri. However, after Katerina's mother faked her death and left the child to be raised by her father, the Ottoman Bulgarian noble Petrov and his second wife, Katerina's path would cross with that of Niklaus and his family, her escaping the ritual of which could unlock his hybrid powers through the actions of her trusted handmaiden, Gudren, as Katerina was a human female of the same /bloodline/ as Tatia, and resulting in Katerina's transition into a vampire.



Traveling with Klaus for many years, Katerina would later be made to forget her connection with him, Klaus making her believe she was on the run from him to protect her from his father Mikael, an event which would lead to Katerina turning the Salvatore brothers into vampires.

In the modern era, the Guardian Elizabeth would bore another three children, Elena, Jeremy, and Margaret Gilbert. Except when their parents refused to give Elena up when she was 13 years-old actions were taken to take her forcefully, though her parents would die in this attempt, their car crashing off a bridge and the vampire Stefan Salvatore saving the child when he was visiting his human relative, Zach Salvatore. *Thus begins The Vampire Diaries.*

SEASON ONE

Season one begins four years after the death of Elena, Jeremy, and Margaret Gilbert's parents with the siblings, their cousin John Myers who had lived with them for a number of years following the disappearance of his parents, and their 'aunt' Jenna returning from a family trip to Paris, Bonnie McCullough-Bennett returning from a trip to visit family in Scotland, and the vampiric Salvatore brothers seemingly drawn toward Mystic Falls by some force (Katherine). Notable characterizations that are drawn more heavily from the books include: Bonnie, Elena, Stefan, and Katerina. In this version of events, while the general base of the season is followed there are some differences. Elena and Caroline have a much more tense dynamic/rivalry- the core friendships being between Elena, Bonnie, Stefan, and Matt. Stefan does not immediately show interest in Elena (quite the opposite) as he continues to think of Katherine. Mrs. Flowers from the books also makes an appearance as the caretaker of the Boarding House, her having been left ownership of it after Zach's death. Bonnie is aware of her /psychic/ and witch background (though at the beginning of the season she's more knowledgeable about her psychic nature and learns more about her witch nature throughout the season). John Myers' best friend is a witch named Davina Zelenko who he discovers the existence of the supernatural from unknowing of Elena also being involved in it; together they uncover that Davina's parents have been using dark magic and killing people and the two stop them. Matt discovers that vampires are in town after his sister's death. Elena is much more accepting of Stefan's vampiric nature immediately. Katherine is in town the entire length of the season though no one is aware of this. The time between the beginning of school year and Vikki's attack has also been lengthened, Stefan and Elena beginning to date after the chaos of events surrounding the 'animal attack' at the party draws them together (it can be noted that the initial attack on Vikki was committed by Katherine though this was unknown to everyone at the time). In addition, Bonnie does not leave town for a time and she is more open to vampires, her more readily willing to help Elena and Stefan during the events of Founder's day and Isobel is not Elena's mother. At the end of the season, Katherine does not kiss Damon as Elena though Katherine does make an appearance.

SEASON TWO

As with season one, this season follows the general base of the show while featuring some key differences. In contrast with canon, while Katherine seeks to destroy Elena and plays mind games with the brothers-- her angry that they both care for Elena when Kat had originally influenced them to remember her-- events take a turn when, after she is locked in the tomb, it is discovered that she and Elena are half-sisters. Due to this, Katherine and Elena begrudgingly begin to become more civil toward one another as Katherine learns more about their mother and she comes to know Jeremy and Margaret.

Later, after Klaus arrives, Katherine is granted her memories back, Klaus ending his compulsion on her and her remembering the connection they once had. In respect to the ritual, John Gilbert was turned into a vampire and used in the ritual instead of Jenna and Elena is turned into a vampire with Damon's blood in her system, her awakening in a confused state and Katherine giving him the cure from Klaus. Following Stefan and Klaus leaving town, Katherine remains for a short time before leaving to track Stefan, her ending up traveling with them throughout the summer once she's discovered.



SEASON THREE

Season three, while following the general base of the show, includes a few core alterations which drive the story in somewhat different directions. Upon Katherine, Klaus, and Stefan's return to town Klaus, discovering Elena is a vampire and not dead, uses her little sister's blood to create hybrids (through blood draws); something which is eventually halted when Bonnie uncovers a ritual to protect Margaret from her blood being taken. Katherine is also killed during Klaus' party by Mikael. Over the course of the season, Elena also discovers she has access to some magic and abilities which are not normal for a vampire prompting further research into her mother's background.

It can be noted that Elena does not stab Rebekah in the back nor does she stand by while Esther plots the demise of her entire family, her informing Elijah of his mother's plans. Due to Jenna still being alive, Alaric and Jenna remain together and he becomes a father figure to Margaret. At the end of the season, Elena, realizing her link to Alaric, stakes herself in the heart to stop him from killing the others.

Following her funeral, Elena /remains dead/ through graduation and storylines including the cure arc are ignored completely. This time also sees the introduction of Enzo St. John, a vampire who Bonnie first encounters on a college visit to Whittmore while he is on a mission for Wes Maxfield. Drawn toward him, Bonnie begins to have a series of psychic dream encounters with Enzo which leads to her aiding in the escape plan organized by followers of the Original Celine Mikaelson-- who had been locked in a prison world for centuries. Everyone also finds themselves having dream visits from Elena who has not fully crossed over. Meanwhile, the Originals return to New Orleans to find Marcel running the town and Klaus enlists a witch to aid him in resurrecting Katerina, which he succeeds in. However, Katerina does not return as a vampire, instead as a human witch.



THE ORIGINALS: S1

Season one begins with Elena Gilbert resurrected in a flash of lightning and Bonnie telling Stefan he needs to get to New Orleans because she felt.. Elena. Finding her in a confused state, more spirit than human, Stefan works to protect her from growing tensions in the Quarter and Earth Guardians who seem to be looking for her. Meanwhile, while Hayley still exists and is in New Orleans it is Katerina who discovers herself pregnant, her Guardian heritage seemingly allowing a loophole in nature.

From there much of the base of the season is followed with additions of Klaus and Katerina being much closer than him and Hayley were, Elena finds herself torn between the Earth Guardian faction in the city and her family, Bonnie and Matt are accepted into college in NOLA, and Enzo arrives in New Orleans with his and Celine's vampiric army-- them having discovered a way to bring Celine back. By the end of the season, power dynamics in the city have altered, the Mikaelson's back on top, Kat and Klaus' daughter Nadia being born, and Elena, Stefan, Matt, and Bonnie preparing for college.

THE ORIGINALS: S2 - ONGOING ->

The current 'present' time of this verse's storyline picks up a few months later as Esther, Mikael, Kol, Henrik, and Finn have found themselves resurrected and Dahlia makes an appearance seeking to take Nadia for herself-- and she's not alone, the witches, the Earth Guardians, and the like all seeming to want to use the girl's power for their own means.

KLAUS MIKAELSON

Original Hybrid. Has taken back control of the French Quarter. Soulmate of Katerina Petrova. Father of Nadia Mikaelson. Half-brother of Celine, Rebekah, Freya, Kol, Finn, Henrik, and Elijah Mikaelson.



STEFAN SALVATORE

Vampire. Brother of Damon Salvatore. Soulmate and boyfriend of Elena Gilbert. Ex-Lover of Katerina Petrova. Very broody.



ELENA GILBERT

Vampire. Ghost. Earth Guardian. Half-sister of Katerina Petrova. Full sister of Margaret and Jeremy Gilbert. Cousin of John Myers. Aunt of Nadia Mikaelson. Soulmate of Stefan Salvatore. College Student in NOLA.



HENRIK MIKAELSON

Warlock. Uncle of Nadia. Half-brother of Celine and Klaus, brother of Rebekah, Freya, Kol, Finn, and Elijah Mikaelson. Recently resurrected.



CELINE MIKAELSON

Original Vampire. Siphoner. Half-sister of Elijah, Klaus, Finn, Kol, Henrik, Freya, and Rebekah. Head of a vampire army. Adoptive mother and sire of Enzo St. John.



BONNIE MCCULLOUGH- BENNETT

Druid. Witch. Psychic. Sister of Mary McCullough-Bennett.. Best friend of Elena Gilbert and Stefan Salvatore. Soulmate of Enzo St. John. College student in NOLA.



ENZO ST. JOHN

Vampire. Right-hand of Celine Mikaelson and co-leader of her vampire army. Adopted son of Celine. Soulmate of Bonnie McCullough-Bennett. Augustine Vampire.



KATERINA PETROVA

Earth Guardian-Vampire Hybrid. Half-sister of Elena, Jeremy, and Margaret Gilbert. Soulmate of Klaus Mikaelson. Mother of Nadia Mikaelson. Ex-lover of the Salvatores.



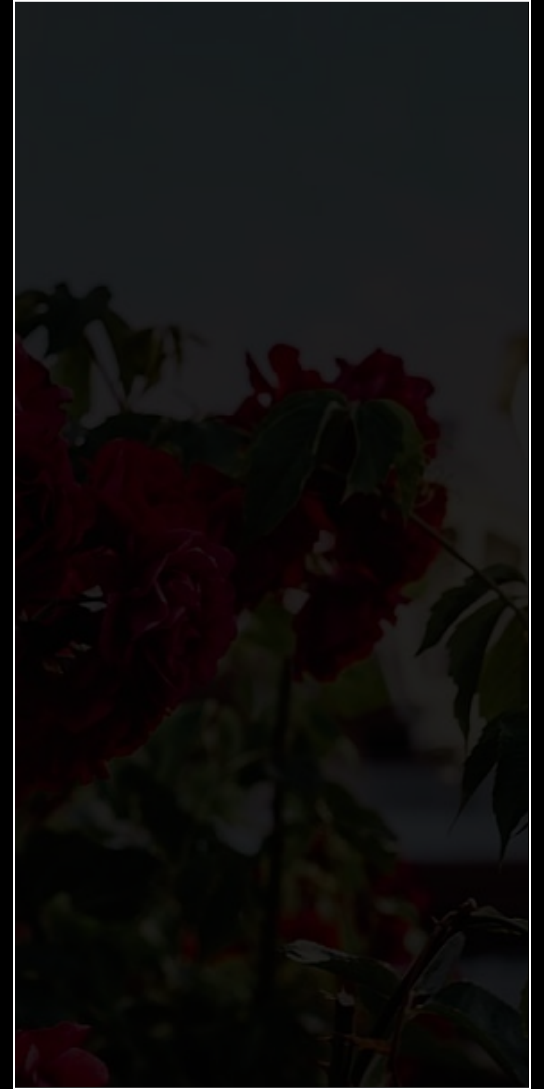
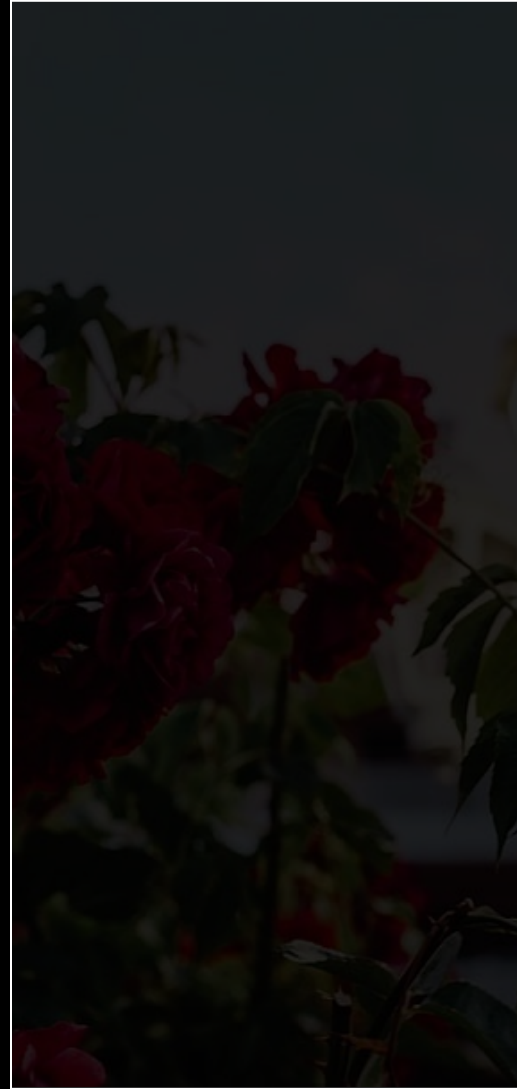
DAVINA ZELENKO
