COVID Cleaning Plan 2022-2023

Screven County Board of Education will follow CDC and Georgia Department of Health guidelines for cleaning. Screven County Maintenance & Operations and Bazemore Services have created the following plan to create a clean environment for students and staff.

- All school buildings will be sanitized daily by Bazemore Services. This sanitization will include treating all areas with an approved disinfectant applied by electrostatic sprayers. The electrostatic sprayer allows for better coverage on surfaces. Products being used are EPA registered and have shown to kill COVID-19.
- Bazemore Services and the SCSS BOE maintenance staff will wipe down high-touched surfaces (doors, front desk, front lobby) frequently during the day.
- Restrooms will be cleaned throughout the day and will be sanitized every afternoon.
- Cafeteria area will be wiped down by the food service staff between servings.
- Teachers will be provided with a spray bottle of BIOSQUE, gloves, and disposable towels to use in their classroom. These products will take the place of Clorox wipes.
- Buses will be sanitized after the morning and afternoon routes.
