



### Office Max Donation:

### **School Uniforms:**

Beginning November in the second quarter, uniforms should be worn Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. Wednesdays are free dress day. If your child has a college shirt, have them wear it on Fridays in place of your uniform! ### **Out of State Traveling:**

If you are considering out of state traveling please be aware of the guidelines for returning to school. Per the DOE travel policy, students must follow the Hawaii Safe Travels Guidelines AND meet one of the following criteria:

- 1. Be fully vaccinated prior to the start of out-of-state travel and provide proof of vaccination to the school;
- 2. Obtain a COVID-19 test after return and submit a negative test result to the school; or
- 3. Quarantine for 10 days after return.

Travelers are not required to do pre-travel testing or quarantine for COVID-19 when traveling between islands.

### **Wellness Checks:**

All HIDOE staff, contracted service providers, visitors and students must complete a wellness check each morning before going to the school/office.

Testing is open to students and staff at Aiea Elementary School, vaccinated or unvaccinated and is a great tool for surveillance purposes to manage the effects of COVID-19 on our school community. Screening takes place every Tuesday. Please email the school nurse: dcaton@ucera.org to let us know how often you would like your child tested. It can be on a weekly, bi weekly, or monthly basis. You can also

notify your teacher about the frequency of testing and they will pass the message along to the nurse.

#### **IMPORTANT REMINDERS:**

During the COVID-19 pandemic, we are finding many students do not have updated contact information or mailing addresses. For the safety of your child as well as the dissemination of information, it's imperative that parents/guardians keep the school updated

whenever phone numbers, addresses, or guardianship has changed. Please inform our school as soon as a change has been made.

- \*CONTACT INFORMATION such as telephone numbers, addresses and emergency contacts are the parents/guardians responsibility to update. Inform the school office of all changes. This is important for attendance, safe to school and home procedures, as well as in emergencies on school campus.
- \*LEGAL DOCUMENTS such as guardianship and power of attorney papers are the parents/guardians responsibility to update. Keep the school office informed of any changes and submit current copies of legal documents. This is especially important for children that move out of state or transfer to another Hawaii Department of Education (HIDOE) school.
- \*TRANSFERRING CHILDREN OUT OF SCHOOL: parents/guardians please notify the office at least 1 week before the child's last attended day. The office will provide a release packet for the next school. The release packet may take 2 3 days to complete. The release packet is required when transferring to another HDOE school or will help with registering at a private school or an out of state school.
