



## Morass CIC – Ceramic Painting Price List & Payment Policy

### Pricing

Participants choose a ceramic item to paint during the session. Prices vary depending on the item selected.

Typical items may include:

- Small items (e.g. ornaments, small pots): £5 – £12
- Medium items (e.g. mugs, bowls): £12 – £18
- Larger items (e.g. plates, decorative pieces): £18 – £30

All prices include:

- Use of ceramic paints
- Glazing
- Kiln firing
- Studio materials

Exact prices for each item will be clearly displayed during the workshop.

### Payment

- Payment is due once your item has been painted.
- Payment can be made by cash or card.
- All prices include materials and firing unless stated otherwise.

### Firing and Collection

- Painted items are glazed and fired in the kiln after the workshop.
- Items are usually ready for collection within 7–10 days.
- Participants will be notified when their item is ready.

Due to limited storage space:

- Items must be collected within 1 months.

#### Use of Materials



- Non-toxic ceramic paints and materials are used during workshops.
- Participants must follow instructions given by staff or facilitators when using paints and equipment.

### **Personal Responsibility**

- Participants take part in workshops at their own discretion.
- Morass CIC cannot be held responsible for damage to clothing or personal belongings during the activity.

Participants are advised to wear clothing suitable for painting.

### **Children**

- Children under 16 years old must be accompanied by a responsible adult unless the session is advertised as supervised.
- Parents and guardians remain responsible for supervising children during the workshop.

### **Ceramic Firing**

- Ceramic items go through a kiln firing process after painting.
- Occasionally items may crack or break during firing due to the nature of ceramics.

While every effort is made to handle pieces carefully, Morass CIC cannot guarantee the outcome of kiln-fired items.

### **Photography**

Morass CIC may occasionally take photographs during workshops for promotional purposes. Participants can inform staff if they prefer not to be photographed.
