

Two-Tone Flora Take Care

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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Two-Tone Flora (160844); Cup of Tea (158661)
- **Card Stock and Paper:** Basic White cardstock (159276); Basic Gray cardstock (121044); Tahitian Tide cardstock (159261)
- **Stamp Pads & Ink:** Tahitian Tide ink pad (159210); Granny Apple Green ink pad (147095); VersaMark (102283)
- **Tools:** Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Two-Tone Flora dies (159181); Painted Labels dies (151605); Basics 3D Embossing Folders (161598); Heat Tool (129053); Paper Snips Scissors (103579)
- **Miscellaneous:** Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Stampin' Seal (152813); multi-Purpose Liquid Adhesive (110755); 2022-2024 In Color Baker's Twine (159195); Stampin' Emboss Powder Basics (155554); Elegant Faceted Gems (152464)



Measurements:

- Tahitian Tide cardstock: 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" (score at 4 1/4")
- Basic Gray cardstock: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8", scrap for stamping/die cutting
- Basic White cardstock: 3 3/4" x 5", scrap for stamping/die cutting
- Baker's Twine (Tahitian Tide): approx. 6"
- Elegant Faceted Gems (clear): 5

Instructions:

1. Fold the Tahitian Tide cardstock in half to create the card base.
2. Emboss the Basic White card layer with the Basics 3D Embossing Folders (cross hatch pattern). Stick the embossed white layer to the Basic Gray layer and then stick them onto the Tahitian Tide card base.
3. On a scrap of Basic White cardstock, stamp five of the double leaf image with Granny Apple Green ink. Also stamp three roses (the flower that looks like it has a little moustache in the middle!) with Tahitian Tide ink. Stamp the detail image with full strength ink. Ink up the "fill in" or solid image, stamp it off on scrap paper and then stamp it over the detail image.
 - a. TIP: Line up the middle of the flower for perfect placement. For this flower, line up the little moustaches!

4. Die cut the flowers and leaves.
5. On a scrap of Basic Gray cardstock, stamp the "Take care of yourself" sentiment with VersaMark ink. Sprinkle white embossing powder over it, tap off the excess and heat with the heat tool until the image is raised and shiny. Die cut it out with a rectangle shaped label from the Painted Labels dies.
6. Place the sentiment label on the embossed white layer (don't stick it down yet...just use it as a guide for flower placement for now!). You want it to be centered left to right, and a little above the middle. Using the label as a guide, position two of the roses and 3 of the leaves partially under the upper left corner of the label. See the picture for exact placement. Use Multi-purpose glue to stick them down. Then do the same for the remaining rose and leaves, but position it under the bottom right corner of the label.
7. Once the roses are in place, use Stampin' Dimensionals to stick the label on.
8. Tie a bow with some Tahitian Tide Baker's Twine. Using a small dot of liquid glue, stick the bow just under the right side of the sentiment.
9. Finish the card with some Elegant Faceted Gems (clear ones). See the picture for placement.
