In order to run the XC portion of this event we need jump judges--**please help us by providing a jump judge volunteer**. If we don't have enough XC jump judges we will not be able to run the XC phase of this event. EVERY PERSON planning to attend must also sign the [release forms](#) before arriving at Pine Hill.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Pine Hill Enterprises and the show management or its employees, or STEA will not be responsible for any loss or damage or injury to persons, horses or property. Each minor exhibitor must have a parent, guardian or qualified instructor sign the release incorporated in the entry form. Each entrant is responsible for riding a properly conditioned horse in a safe manner. Management reserves the right to stop and eliminate unsafe riders or improperly conditioned horses.
2. **XC Schooling** under the supervision of a qualified instructor will be allowed after the show has completed.
3. For this show there will be **no XC Schooling on Saturday** Properly fitting helmet with permanent harness & boots with heels required whenever mounted. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible.
4. Riders must provide their own "Pinny Holder" for Cross Country. Paper number inserts will be provided. Pinney Holders are available through [SmartPak](#) or [Amazon](#).
5. Unless otherwise stipulated the competitions will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the United States Eventing Association as described in the [current rule book](#).
6. Ribbons will be awarded through sixth place. Divisions with sufficient entries will be split into sections.
7. Concessions--French Food Corner Food Truck--Sunday only.
8. **Stabling** is available on a limited basis-- Overnight stabling Saturday night must be requested on the entry form and you must specify an approximate arrival time (between 12 pm and 6 pm on Saturday) so that we can check you in. Qualified and experienced EMT will be available during show.

10. **RV Hookups** (electric only) —limited availability. Must be requested on the entry form and you must specify an approximate arrival time (between 12 pm and 6 pm on Saturday)

Stadium	10-12 jumping efforts, ~450 m @ 350 mpm, max height 3' 11"
Cross-Country	Same as Preliminary

PRELIMINARY	Open to horse/rider combinations who have completed at least 4 events at the Training Level.
Dressage	2022 USEF PRELIMINARY TEST A (20m x 40m arena)
Stadium	10-12 jumping efforts, ~450 m @ 350 mpm, max height 3' 7"
Cross-Country	18-22 jumping efforts, ~2500 m @ 520 mpm, max height 3' 7"

TRAINING	Open to horse/rider combinations who have not completed more than 2 Preliminary events in the past 24 months.
Dressage	2022 USEF TRAINING TEST A (20m x 40m arena)
Stadium	8-12 jumping efforts, ~450m @ 325 mpm, max height 3' 3"
Cross-Country	16-20 jumping efforts, ~2500 m @ 420 mpm, max height 3' 3"

NOVICE	Open to horse/rider combinations who have not completed more than 2 Training events in the past 24 months.
Dressage	2022 USEF NOVICE Test A (20m x 40m arena)
Stadium	8-10 jumping efforts, ~450 m @ 320 mpm, max height 2' 11"
Cross-Country	12-18 jumping efforts, ~1800 m @ 375 mpm, max height 2' 11"

BEGINNER NOVICE	Open to horse/rider combinations who have not completed more than 2 Novice events in the past 24 months.
Dressage	2022 USEF BEGINNER NOVICE TEST A (20m x 40m arena)
Stadium	8-10 jumping efforts, ~350 m @ 300 mpm, max height 2' 6"
Cross-Country	12-18 jumping efforts, ~1500 m @ 350 mpm, max height 2' 9" Course will be straightforward and inviting.

GOLDILOCKS	Open to horse/rider combinations who have not completed more than 2 Beginner Novice events in the past 24 months.
Dressage	2022 USEA STARTER TEST (20m x 40m arena) Test may be called.
Stadium	8-10 jumping efforts, ~350 m (no time penalties), max height 2' 3" No combinations, inviting first fence.
Cross-Country	10-14 jumping efforts, ~1200 m @ 320 mpm, max height 2' 3" Time will count. Course will be straightforward and inviting. Water crossing optional; some jumps in the woods.

GREEN AS GRASS	Open to horses that have not competed above the Beginner Novice level or riders who have not competed Beginner Novice or above.
Dressage	For CT Only: 2023 USDF Intro Test A (20m x 40m arena) Test may be called. For HT Only: 2023 USDF Intro Test C (20m x 40m arena) Test may be called.
Stadium	6-8 jumping efforts, ~350 m (no time penalties), max height 2' Mostly cross rails
Cross-Country	6-10 jumping efforts, ~800 m @ 275 mpm, max height 2' Time will count. Very straightforward jumping efforts in the field.

Distances and speeds may be modified according to conditions.

PLEASE NOTE:

Absolutely no changes of division will be allowed (ie: from HT to CT) once the rider has completed their dressage test. All changes must be cleared with the show office before the rider begins the competition.
