

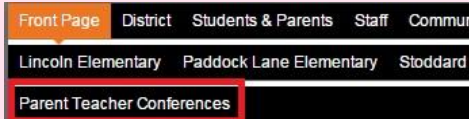

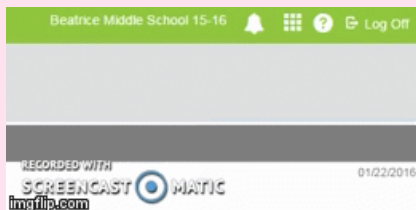


BPS Website News

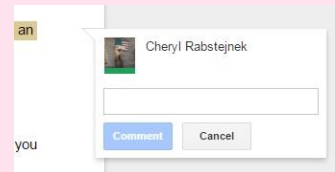

Google App Tip

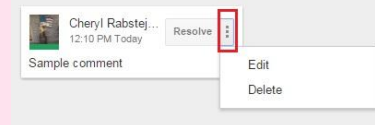
New...Comment on a Google Doc

In a Google Doc:

- Highlight Text to comment on.
- A Box will come up on the right side
- Click on the Box
- A Comment window will come up. Type in your comment.



- Hit Comment
- To Edit or remove a comment:
- Choose the Comment
- Hit the 3 dots



- Choose Edit or Delete
- You can also hit Resolve

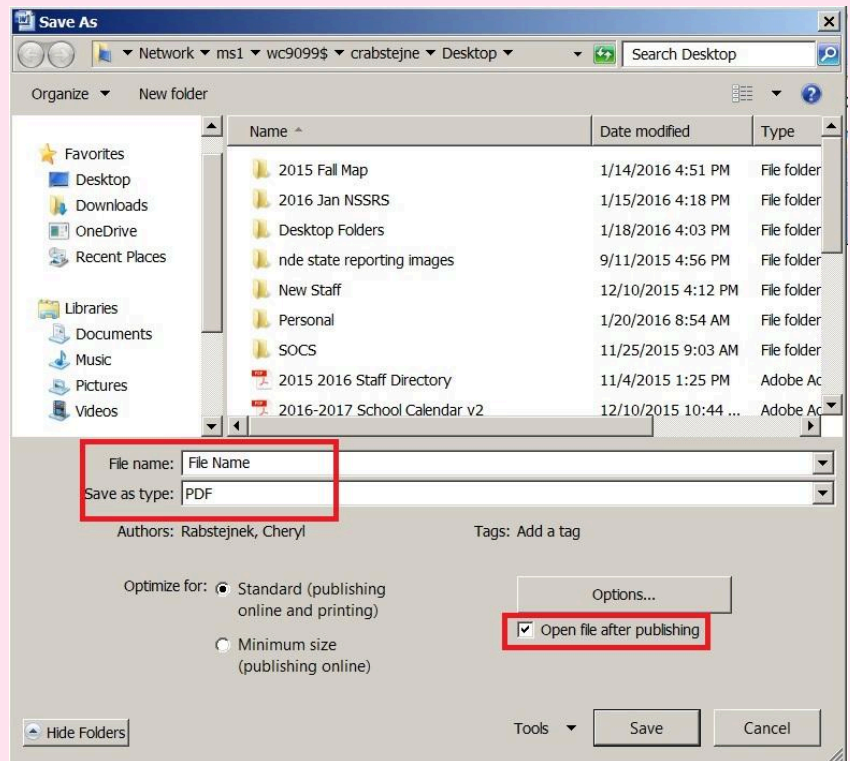

PDF Files

Create a PDF from a Word Document:

- Open the file in Word
- Make any changes needed.
- Go to - **SAVE AS**
- Enter file Name
- Save as type - **PDF**
- You can choose to have the file open as a PDF after saving if you wish.
- Hit **SAVE**



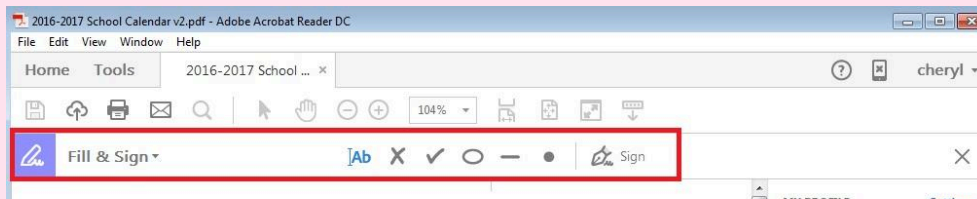
Adobe Acrobat Reader DC

Acrobat Reader should already be installed on your computer. You may need to update to get the DC version

- With Acrobat Reader DC, you can do more than open and view PDF files.
- Add annotations to documents using **Commenting tools**.



- Use the new **Fill & Sign** tool to complete PDF forms or markup a PDF.
