Important information for the 2025 ski season

Refund policies: Prior to December 1st, Bradley will refund all money if needed due to student cancellation. After this date, a refund is not guaranteed. Money will be refunded if another student signs up from the waitlist. We are UNABLE to refund any money paid to Mad River. If a student does not go on the Holiday Valley trip, the cost of their lift ticket will be refunded, but their bus ticket will not. If we are unable to get in 5 trips to Mad River, or the Holiday Valley trip- all monies paid to HCSD will be refunded.

Ski Club will be canceled if:

- A. Mad River is closed (check their website www.skimadriver.com or follow them on Instagram). Mrs. Waller will also send out a "remind" message.
- B. School is closed and the Superintendent has canceled all high school events. Sometimes HS events are still scheduled. Message will be sent by noon on the status of our MRM trip.
- C. Weather deems it necessary. Mad River is 45 min from HBHS, we don't return until 9:30pm, it may be necessary to postpone our trip, even though HBHS holds other activities.

*Please be sure to sign up for REMIND for all pertinent announcements regarding closings. There may be days when school is canceled but we will still take our ski club trip.

Storing Gear on Thursdays

Students are responsible for stowing their own gear before school in Room C290 from 7:20-7:40 AM. DO NOT LEAVE YOUR BELONGINGS IN THE HALLWAY! Advisors and teachers will not be responsible for items left outside C290. After school, students can retrieve their gear between 2:30-2:40 PM. The bus leaves promptly at 2:45 PM! Busses will be locked while we snowboard and ski (until approximately 8:25 PM). You cannot get in HBHS after ski club.

Step 1 of 3: Bus information: Pay Hilliard City Schools

- Club cost for bus transportation: \$100. We have a limit of 50 bus seats. Ideally, secure a bus seat before buying/paying for anything else. Pay for this using https://www.mypaymentsplus.com/, same as paying sports fees, iPad protection plan, etc. Deadline: Friday, Dec. 6th (Payment opens on Friday, October 25th)
- 2. Sign into Home Access and verify emergency contact information. We will take a copy of this to MRM.
- 3. We will be using Cardinal Transportation charter coaches.

Step 2 of 3: Lift Tickets and Ski Passes: PAY Mad River Directly

Mad River Rental Waiver (if renting at MRM): Needs to be completed AND TURNED IN TO MRS. WALLER'S mailbox in the main office by Monday, December 6th. Copies of this waiver will be available in room A214.
OPTION TWO: EPIC OHIO PASS	 If you plan to go to Mad River way more than just with Ski and Board Club https://www.epicpass.com/Passes/Ohio-Pass.aspx Valid every single day Mad River is open \$300 for ages 7-17 (\$380 for adults 18 and over) Access Mad River, Alpine Valley, Boston Mills, Brandywine. Includes Epic Mountain Rewards – 20% off food, lodging, lessons, rentals and more. Refunds for job loss, injury, illness & more with Epic Coverage. Plus, discounted tickets for you, friends and family NOTE: This is ONLY lift ticket - equipment is not included with an Epic Pass
OPTION THREE: TICKET WINDOW	More of an "a la carte" route- if you have your own equipment and don't want lessons • Single-day after-3pm tickets (Mon-Thur): \$55 for ages 13-64 • The Epic 5-Day Pass is currently \$241 for ages 13+

Step 3 of 3: Label / Get Your Gear Ready

- HELMETS: Students ARE REQUIRED to wear helmets.
- Students are responsible for their own clothing. Please label clothing (specifically gloves and helmets, usually can be labeled inside) with your name. Also many gear bags look the same... and are black... and were bought at the same places. :-)
- Cubbies will be available to store bags / dinner. Do not leave loose items in the cubbies. Easily visible shoes, gloves, goggles might disappear...
- Students can leave extra clothing and backpacks on the bus but they will NOT have access to those items while we are on the slopes. District iPads **must** remain on the bus.
- Students can lock valuables in pay lockers in the **rental building**. <u>Credit Card/Debit only</u>. In the past they were \$5.00 for small and \$8.00 for large. These have unlimited in/out privileges for the night. Share one with friends!

Clothing Recommendations Try not to wear cotton (jeans / sweatpants) as it absorbs water and sweat. Try to wear: long underwear, warm socks, polar fleece, "turtle fur" brand, all outerwear should be waterproof (coat, pants, gloves).

When preparing for trips: check **multiple** times you have **all items**. It's very tough to "fix" arriving at MRM without a coat... or gloves... or pants... Here is a good list from Mr. Banyots- Weaver's ski advisor. Mr. B's Checklist bit.ly/sbceqchecklist to make sure you are prepared AND get things squared away after coming home.

Buying Stuff at Mad River

Mad River is cashless. Credit/Debit, Apple/Google Pay, Mad River gift cards are the easiest choices. "Resort Charging" can be set up IF you have a season Epic pass with your student's photo on it.

- o Apple Pay and Google Pay for food in the Cafeteria, and the Retail Shop
- o Mad River gift cards for food in the Cafeteria, and the Retail Shop
 - Purchase these at Mad River.
- Credit/Debit cards for food, retail shop and Pay Lockers
- **Resort Charging** for anything *except* pay lockers. This can be set up IF you have a season Epic pass with your student's photo on it.

Ski & Board Club Guidelines (Rules!)

The following list of guidelines is designed for the safe operation of the Bradley High School Ski & Board Club. The understanding of and adherence to these guidelines by students and parents is essential. All students in the club are subject to all Board of Education policies and Bradley High School rules. If a student is found in violation of any of these rules, they will be subject to the penalties noted in the Student Handbook and could be removed from Ski & Board Club for the season. There are no refunds from Ski & Board Club or Mad River Mountain if a student is removed from the Club. Any student who is suspended or expelled from school cannot attend Ski & Board Club during that time.

1. All students will travel to and from Mad River Mountain on the assigned transportation. No student will travel by any other means to or from MRM

- unless arrangements are personally made between Mrs. Waller / Ms. Baker and parents/guardians.
- 2. Students are expected to ski and board in designated areas only.
- Students are expected to comply with reasonable requests of Ski & Board Club advisors.
- 4. Students are expected to obey all safety rules and any request of the Ski Patrol or MRM employees. A student who does not comply can be removed from Ski & Board Club for the remainder of the season.
- 5. The Loft is OFF limits to Club members. If you need to find a chaperoneyou may quickly go up to seek one out- we are up there because it's quiet and we can get work done if needed.
- 6. Students are to be on the bus to return to Bradley by 8:45 pm at the latest. The buses will open at 8:30.
- 7. If there is an injury, Ski Patrol or a Bradley advisor will call the phone number on the emergency forms which are printed from Home Access. Parents may be expected to pick up their child at Mad River Mountain. Please keep this in mind when making Thursday evening plans. The bus will not transport a severely injured student.
- 8. Ski & Board Club members are expected to be in school on Fridays. Being "too tired" from Ski & Board Club is not an acceptable excuse for missing school.
- 9. If a student is removed from Ski & Board Club for any disciplinary reason, the Club transportation cost is non-refundable, and the student may forfeit any MRM passes also without refund.
