YELL members met at the SRDC November 8, 2021, International Summit in Monrovia, Liberia. During the conference they registered 55 people from Liberia and the Western Diaspora to form an economic empowerment and advocacy organization for job creation, business creation in all sectors in the Liberian Economy. On November 26, 2021 Youth Empowering Legislative Law (YELL) was formed as an national non-profit organization.

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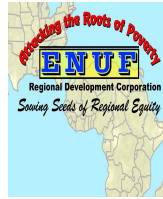
