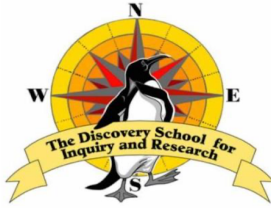

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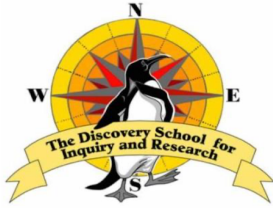

- **Welcome and Thank You from Principal Serin**
- **Parent Chat**
 - Mr. Serin states that it was enjoyable and feedback from parents was used. Ms. Wang will contact parents for more participation.
- **PS201 Parent University**
 - Professional learning for parents is being conducted based on parent surveys.
 - Mr. Serin encourages parents to contact him with any questions and needs.
- **Student Chat**
 - Conducted on a monthly basis with one student representative from each grade level. Students share their experiences. The discussions focus on learning and SEL.

Acadience, Iready Reading and Math. As expected many students scored below grade level. Teachers will use the data broken down by standards and skills for small groups. Teachers are analysing data to come up with next steps. Teachers will share the IReady-family facing report. Parents will use these reports to help their students at home. Parents can bring the report to parent teacher conferences to discuss questions.
- **Attendance Report**



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- Attendance is still an issue. Our attendance was below 80 percent, 99 students were absent. Mr, Serin is worried about how we can best address the learning loss that occurred over the last 16 months with so many absences. The attendance team is putting systems and structures in place to understand and help parents of students with chronic absences share the issues that are affecting their child's attendance and come up with solutions.

- **CEP Progress Monitoring**

- Mr Serin has been attending PDs on integrating equity and CRSE into our curriculum and work. We will revisit our visions and goals using the equity rubric.

As we gather more student data particularly mid-year, we will revisit our goals and address deficiencies.

- **Academic Recovery Services & After-School Programs**

- Students with IEPs will receive services. We are reaching out to parents to see if afternoon services are wanted. We will then reach out to gen-ed students. Parents will hear more in the upcoming weeks.

- **Partnership with Pomonk After-School Program and Best Prep**

- Best Prep will provide after school support for up to 20 students.

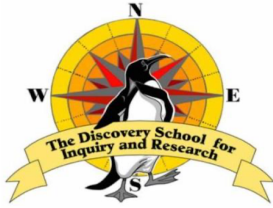
- **Report Cards**
