Confirmation Guidelines – Diocese of Lubbock



1. Confirmation of Minors

- Unless delegated by the Bishop or in an emergency, **only the Bishop can confirm a minor**.
- Exception:
 - o If a minor (age 7–17) has never been baptized in the Catholic Church, they must receive all three Sacraments of Initiation during the same celebration, by the same celebrant:
 - Baptism (or Profession of Faith)
 - Confirmation
 - Eucharist
 - (Formation through OCIA adapted for youth/children).

2. Curriculum for Confirmation

- The Diocesan Curriculum must be used for all Confirmation classes.
- Parishes are responsible for preparing all students for Confirmation:
 - o **8th grade or younger:** Confirmed at the parish.
 - o High School students: Confirmed at the Cathedral on August 30, 2026, at 4:30 Mass
- Parishes must **provide sacramental information** for each high school student being confirmed.

3. Confirmation Preparation

- The Pastor or Parish Administrator is ultimately responsible for guiding and overseeing the sacramental preparation for Confirmation.
- The Diocese of Lubbock encourages meaningful and thoughtful preparation, but does
 not consider the following to be required conditions for receiving the Sacrament of
 Confirmation:
 - o A two-year preparation program.
 - o A set number of service hours.
 - o Documented Mass attendance.
 - o A formal Confirmation test.
 - o Participation in a retreat before Confirmation.

Note: The Sacrament of Confirmation, like all sacraments, is a free and unearned gift of God's grace. True, grace-filled preparation focuses on deepening the candidate's relationship with God and nurturing a life of faith.

4. Retreats and Overnight Events

- High school students:
 - o Overnight retreats or travel **must be pre-approved by Bishop Coerver** before announcing or fundraising at the parish level.
 - o Allow at least one month for approval (pending the Bishop's schedule).
- Students younger than 9th grade:
 - o Permission will not be given for overnight events.

5. Inviting Speakers

- When a parish wishes to invite a speaker from outside the Diocese of Lubbock to their parish, the following steps are required:
 - o Obtain prior approval from the Office of the Bishop.
 - o Submit a current letter of good standing from the speaker's parish or diocese.
 - o Provide proof of Safe Environment compliance.
- **Timeline:** All documentation should be submitted at least one month before the scheduled event.

6. Safe Environment Requirements

- All parish personnel working with minors must have current Safe Environment clearance.
- Each parish is required to offer a **yearly Circle of Grace class** to all minors.
- Elementary and high school students may not be in the same classes.
