YOKAI, MONSTERS, + SPIRITS

- **Nekomata:** Two-tailed cats. Tend to cluster in the classrooms. Seemingly harmless.
- **Jinmenken:** Dogs with human faces. Capable of imitating loved ones' voices and faces. Weak individually.
- **Omukade:** Giant centipedes. Not venomous, but their bites are still quite painful.

THE ORIGINAL ANZEN

- Was part of a smaller group of students brought here from elsewhere, much the same as we were. They presumably all died and are now ghosts haunting the school.
- "Brave. Not very strong, though. A little stupid!" A favorite target of the monsters.
- Blamed themselves for failing to prevent Yakuyoke's death. Shiawase reassured them that "you're not the only one mourning, "it isn't your fault," and "nobody else blames you," but this did little to alleviate the intense burden of guilt.

SCHOOL NURSE
