

Counselor & Class Schedule Guide



When do I receive my schedule?

You will receive your schedule at Schedule Pick Up Day (SPUD) on August 13, 2024. There will be more information about this event sent to you this summer.

What is a typical Junior schedule?

- **Periods 1-4** you will be in your lab.
- **Periods 5-9** you will be placed in English, Math, Social Studies, and Science classes based on grades you received from similar academics that you took while at your home school. You will also have a lunch period.
 - Some programs have a **Related** class. If you have a related class (a class that relates to your lab), you will not take a Science your junior year. You will take your 3rd and final science course your Senior year.
 - If you are in **Cosmetology**, you will take a science course your junior year and Government your senior year.
 - **It is recommended that you complete your Health and PE courses prior to starting at UVCC. Online summer school options are available.**

What is a typical Senior schedule?

- **Periods 1-5** you will be placed in academic courses needed for graduation. You will also be given a lunch period.
 - If you have credit recovery, your counselor will try to work those courses into your senior schedule. If we can not fit the credit recovery course into your schedule, you will be contacted by one of our teachers in the Student Assistance Center, and they will help you set up an online credit recovery course.
- **Periods 6-9** you will be in your lab.

What if I want to make a schedule change?

We will change your schedule for the following reasons:

1. If you are taking CCP courses at Edison, and you were scheduled in all regular academics at UVCC.
2. If you are taking your academics at your home school and we scheduled you for a full day at UVCC.
3. If we missed a core academic course in your schedule, and you **do not** have a Related class.
4. If you have been placed in an academic class that is either too challenging or not challenging enough.

What if I have an IEP?

Your VOSE will help you with all academic questions relating to the parameters of your IEP.

What if I need credit recovery?

If you need to make up credits, we recommend taking summer classes through UVCC or your home school. Contact your UVCC counselor to discuss the available options. Depending on the amount of credits needed, you may be able to wait until senior year.
