### College Tour Assignment

Traditionally, high school juniors spend the spring and summer touring campuses in preparation for the college application process in the fall. As most campuses have been closed since March, many of you have probably not had that chance.

Your assignment is to take virtual tours of THREE college campuses.

1. Start with the site [You Visit](#) and search for a school that might interest you. You can stroll down the list or you can enter in filters, such as: state, setting, and size. For example, I want a private university in a rural setting with fewer than 20 thousand students. I don't care what state. Among my results were Princeton, Monmouth, Widener, Marist, RIT, etc. I am going to click one that looks interesting and take a tour. It may prompt you for your information. You can still do the tours without filling the form. If you want to fill out the form, feel free to use your school email.
2. If you do not find what you are looking for there, try out the site [Campus Tours](#). You can plug your desired major, size, sports, and other parameters into the search engine. For example, I want to major in wildlife biology at a school that offers baseball. Fifteen schools on this site have those two non-negotiables for me.
3. Tour three different schools from either site over the next three days. Fill out the charts below for each school. If you know your intended major, make sure to "visit" the building that houses that major. For example, I want to major in tv broadcast, so I am exploring the communication building at University of Miami (it looks really nice).
