The International Students End of Year Programme will run for three weeks after Senior Prizegiving, which is usually in Week 4 of Term 4. This is costed at \$800

Costs are subject to change should insurance or other costs increase. This does also include homestay fees.

Tuition **NZ \$17,500 per year**

This covers: Full costs of all tuition, stationery, library, individual or small group music tuition, internet and school-issue resources.

Additional Costs *Required school uniform:*

- Plain black school shoes.
- Sports shoes, recommended but are optional.
- Please note, We now ask students to purchase their own school uniforms. We will supply a price list at that time. We can include a fee for this (\$440)

Additional costs can vary in relation to the individual programme selected by the student and are not covered by the standard tuition fee.

They may include:

- non-programmable scientific calculator for Maths, Physics, etc (\$100 approximately)
- Trips out of school (eg- Marine Studies, Surf Trip, Tramping/Camping, Kayaking, Snow Trip and Mountain Biking Trips.)
- Sport Team Fees
- New Zealand Qualifications Entry (NCEA) if necessary (\$400 approximately)
- If the student does not fly into Whakatane Airport we will have to charge transportation fees for a shuttle from Tauranga or Auckland airport. The price for this depends on whether it is shared among a group or individual. The range is \$NZ190 – \$NZ500 (single journey) We would recommend flying into Whakatane airport especially as the airline has a bigger plane now.
- Subject fees where additional materials and equipment are supplied that have a take home component/project. This is only for materials in excess of subject allocation.
- A contingency fee is charged to all students depending on how long their stay is. This covers school trips or International trips that happen over and above the optional costs. Any unused money is refunded.

1 Term = \$1000, 2 Terms = \$1500, 3 Terms = \$1800, 4 Terms = \$2000

Homestay Weekly board - \$360 per week

Coordination components include the cost of meeting the student at Whakatane Airport, transporting to their home stay, and visiting students during their stay. Weekly Board payments cover the cost of home stay supervision, a fully furnished room, all meals and laundry. If the student is absent during the holiday period, a weekly retainer fee is payable. However full weekly board will be invoiced and any adjustments will be made at the end of the stay and refunded back to the student.

Refunds would be considered in terms of the Board of Trustees Refund Policy.
