When and where is the Walk?

NEW LOCATION FOR 2025: NAMIWalks Colorado will take place on Saturday, May, 10th, 2025 at Robert F. Clement Park Amphitheater. The address is 7306 W. Bowles Ave. Littleton, CO 80123.

Where do I check in on Walk Day?

If you plan to Walk, you **MUST** be registered - but don't worry, it's free! Click [here](#) to register online or stop by the registration table on Walk Day. All attendees, including kids do need to be registered, you can register them online ahead of time, or sign a waiver day of Walk.

All participants must check in on Walk Day. NAMIWalks Colorado is also excited to provide online check-in for this year's event. If you've already registered, download the **Fundraise4NAMI app** on the App Store or Google Play via the QR code below, and log in with your Walk registration to check in virtually and skip the line!



How long is the route?

NAMIWalks Colorado route is 1.5 miles long. Strollers, wheelchairs, wagons, dogs on leash, etc... are welcome! [Here](#) is an interactive google map of our walk location. The orange dots indicate the walk route.

What are the Walk Day activities?

NAMIWalks Colorado will be full of fun activities! We'll have:

Where do I park on Walk Day?

Parking is available in the following areas: Follow the signs to Amphitheater (West parking lot) by the O, P, Q pavilions and west playground. This is where registration will be. If the west parking lot is full we have a shuttle service available from the AMC Theater across the street (8035 W. Bowles Ave). A map of the park is [linked here](#). Once you park please come to the registration tents to check-in.

What do I do with donations on Walk Day?

Are Pets allowed at NAMIWalks Colorado?

Yes, pets are allowed as long as they are on a leash and friendly!

Will there be opportunities for photos?

There is a giant chair overlooking the water near the beginning of the walk route as our official NAMIWalks Photo Spot. This will be a great place for pictures. You will be able to take pictures in front of the amphitheater and walk start inflatable arch.

What if it rains on Walk Day?

Our event is rain or shine! However, it may be canceled only in cases of severe and unsafe weather. Our media sponsor Denver7 will be keeping us informed about any adverse weather closures.

How do I get a NAMIWalks T-shirt?

T-shirts are only for individual fundraisers who raise a minimum of \$100. Although we do our best to have many sizes available, we cannot determine the exact needs on Walk Day. All shirts are on a first-come, first-served basis! T-shirts can be picked up next to the registration table.
