MLB: Atlanta Braves vs. Phillies - 1 Unit (-115) - 6:45pm ET

Phillies to win

Analysis:

We like the Phillies will win outright because they have a strong track record as favorites, going 29-15 when on the moneyline this season, including a solid 29-14 when favored by -114 or less. They rank among the top teams offensively with the No. 7 MLB scoring 4.9 runs per game, and their batting average of .261 is third-best in the majors, complemented by a low strikeout rate of 7.8 per game. Their pitching staff is also outstanding, leading MLB with a 9.8 K/9 and sporting a solid 3.72 team ERA. Key players like Kyle Schwarber, with 18 homers and 40 RBIs, Bryce Harper, with a .372 OBP and .450 slugging, and Trea Turner, leading with a .310 average and five homers, give the Phillies a formidable offensive edge. Given their consistent performance and strength across both pitching and hitting, I see no reason why they won't come out on top in this matchup. **The public bets are big on the Phillies with 77% of the bets and 91% of the money on Philadelphia to win this one outright.**

Analysis:

The Knicks' comeback in Sunday's game, requiring a near-flawless fourth quarter, underscored how crucial clutch performances are at this stage of the series, and the question now is whether they can replicate that effort again. While they still heavily rely on Jalen Brunson, Karl-Anthony Towns' standout 20-point fourth quarter highlighted the importance of secondary scoring. Indiana's significant depth advantage, with Rick Carlisle able to deploy an 11-man rotation, is likely to become more impactful as the series progresses and the Knicks' star players log heavy minutes, potentially leading to fatigue and an edge for the Pacers. However, Indiana's key concern remains the health of Aaron Nesmith; as long as he's available, they are poised to rally in Game 4, much like they did after losses to the Bucks and Cavs, demonstrating resilience and the capacity to elevate their game under pressure. If they can maintain that intensity, Indiana has a strong chance to even the series, leveraging their depth and resilience to challenge the Knicks' knockout efforts. **The public bets are also favoring Indiana as 74% of the bets and 70% of the money are on the Pacers to cover here.**
