Education Pathway

Each program could set up an online site where they provide the following type of things for the preschool students they would normally be working with:

- Home activities such as scavenger hunts, easy games with things around the house, etc.
- They could do videos such as a daily storybook reading or build a fort that kids could also build or pretend to be in with them.
- Put on virtual puppet shows, etc.
- Daily exercises like yoga, stretching, jumping jacks.

Health Services

Create an online portal for students and parents to access. Students can upload things like:

- As a class do virtual workouts.
- Daily exercise routines and film themselves demonstrating.
