

Healthy Heart Visual

1. Choose a piece of colored construction paper and use a template to trace a heart shape. Cut the heart out and add your name to the back.
2. Locate 20 pictures and/or symbols (no words) to represent what you want in a healthy relationship. All 20 pictures and/or symbols must fit in the heart shape (try to have little to no overhang).
3. Once you have all of your pictures and/or symbols glued, explain in complete sentences what each means or represents on a separate piece of paper or Google Doc. Write or type large enough so they can be easily read when hung up for display. Example: Shrek: A relationship should go beyond looks.
