1. Introduction

Welcome to **RepoTranslate**. These Terms of Service ("Terms") govern your use of our application. By using RepoTranslate, you agree to be bound by these Terms. If you do not agree, you may not use the service.

2. Service Description

RepoTranslate enables users to translate files within their GitLab repositories. The process works as follows:

- You connect your GitLab repository to RepoTranslate.
- You select a source file and target languages for translation.
- Whenever a merge request is created that modifies the source file, RepoTranslate automatically translates it and commits the translations to the same branch as the merge request.
- The service deducts credits based on the length of the source file and all translated versions.

3. Account Registration and Access

- You must sign in with GitLab to use the service.
- You are responsible for maintaining the security of your GitLab account and API access.
- RepoTranslate is not responsible for unauthorized access due to security breaches on your end.

4. Credits and Payments

- RepoTranslate operates on a credit-based system.
- Credits can be purchased through the application.
- Each translation consumes credits based on the length of the source file plus the length of all generated translations.
- Credits are non-refundable and do not expire unless otherwise stated.

5. User Responsibilities

You agree not to misuse the service, including but not limited to:

- Attempting to reverse-engineer, scrape, or manipulate the system.
- Using automated tools to generate excessive requests.
- Submitting content that violates any applicable laws.
