OSHKOSH YOUTH NAMED ALTERNATE FOR NAVAL ACADEMY APPOINTMENT

Washington — John F. Konrad Jr., 202 Waugoo street, Oshkosh, today was named by Sen. Robert La Follette as alternate for appointment to the U. S. Naval academy at Annapolis. As principal La Follette named Virgil C. Rydeen of Superior.

(John Konrad Jr., is at present attending the University of Wisconsin at Madison. He graduated from the Oshkosh High school with the class of January 1935 and has been at the university since last fall. He went one year to Oshkosh State Teachers college. He is 19 years old and the son of Mr. and Mrs. John F. Konrad. An older brother, Edmund, graduated from the naval academy in 1932 and at present is on assignment to the U. S. S. Trenton at San Diego.)

Capt. John F. Konrad, 202 Waugoo street, was with the Sixth air service command at the Guam air depot and received the American theater service ribbon, Asiatic-Pacific theater service ribbon, the victory medal and two overseas service bars. He entered service Dec. 23, 1943.

Lieutenant Konrad, stationed at Pratt army air field, Kans., has been in service about two years, and is training with B-29's at present. His wife and child are with him at present.
