Poster Presentation Information

Why Participate: We know that school nurses in Virginia are doing great things and we can learn from what others have done. School nurses themselves may not realize the great work they are doing-so we encourage peers to speak to their colleagues and encourage them to participate.

How to Submit a Poster:

Create a poster that describes what you have done, include:

- a. The problem or issue you were solving or addressing
- b. What you did (how you used data, or who you worked with and the innovative activity)
- c. The results: what happened because of your actions?
- d. Lessons learned. What went well, what would you do differently in the future? (think of your audience and what would help them if they wanted to do this)
- e. References: 2-3 evidence-based references that tie into your project
 - This is a required piece in order for posters to be eligible for CE credits.
- f. Your completed poster should be presented on a trifold for easy display at this year's VASN Fall Conference.

How to have a Poster Eligible for a Prize:

- 1. **Qualifications to be eligible to win a prize:** All school nurses in Virginia are eligible. Related school and health professionals jointly submitting are eligible with the school nurse.
 - a. VASN's board members and judging panel are not eligible for the prizes. They may have a poster submitted to share knowledge, but are ineligible for poster prizes
 - b. Allied school professionals or other health professionals who submit a poster without a school nurse co-author are not eligible for prizes.
- 2. Judging: Posters will be voted upon by all attendees of the 38th Annual VASN Conference.
- 3. Categories of Prizes:
 - a. Innovative Solutions 1 award
 - b. Using Data for Change 1 award
- 4. **Scoring/Points System:** Posters will be scored for:
 - a. Idea/solution creativity and advancement of school nursing practice (70%)
 - b. Ease of reading poster (15%)
 - c. Overall presentation (15%)
 - d. Scoring/ranks will not be shared publicly. Winners will be announced during the VASN membership luncheon meeting. ALL DECISIONS ARE FINAL AND NOT ELIGIBLE FOR RE-COUNT OR REVIEW
- 5. **Prizes:** Free VASN memberships for winner in each category



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Poster Presentation SAMPLE

Descriptive Title of Your Project To Help Others Know What you Did (bold it)
Include names of presenters, include your credentials after your name: School Nurse, RN

Problem of Concern

Describe the concern you were trying to address.

Solution

Describe what you did. How did you use data differently or what did you do differently.

Results

Describe what happened as a result of your innovation or how you used data to create change.

Visual

Not required but helpful. Get permission if people are in the picture. Best to use your own photos. Cite and be careful of contribution in increase.

- For others who would like to do what you did, what should they do differently,
- What tips would help them.
- You may want to put these in bullet forms.

Reference

- Add 1-3 evidence-based references.
- This includes evidence such as
