

Behaviors that Promote Learning

Follows directions Examples: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Follows written directions</i>• <i>Follows oral directions</i>	Participates in class Examples: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Contributes to class discussions</i>• <i>Volunteers consistently</i>
Interacts appropriately with others Examples: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Cooperates with others</i>• <i>Shows empathy and compassion for others</i>• <i>Respects others' perspectives and differences</i>• <i>Recognizes how own actions impacts others</i>• <i>Resolves interpersonal conflicts respectfully</i>• <i>Takes responsibility for actions and words</i>	Organizes materials Examples: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Organizes books, papers, writing utensils, etc.</i>• <i>Puts coats/shoes, etc. in locker</i>• <i>Finds missing items without teacher assistance</i>• <i>Puts materials where they belong</i>• <i>Is responsible for items that travel between home and school</i>
Manages emotions Examples: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Thinks before acts</i>• <i>Regulates self to be ready to learn</i>• <i>Manages impulsivity</i>	Self-advocates Examples: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Asks for help when needed</i>• <i>Uses assertive communication</i>• <i>Takes initiative</i>
Embraces challenges Examples: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Perseveres when faced with challenges</i>• <i>Views mistakes productively</i>• <i>Has a growth mindset</i>• <i>Shows resilience</i>	Focuses attention Examples: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Stays on task</i>• <i>Uses time constructively</i>• <i>Starts and finishes tasks independently</i>• <i>Uses active listening strategies</i>
