Behaviors that Promote Learning

Follows directions

Examples:

- Follows written directions
- Follows oral directions

Participates in class

Examples:

- Contributes to class discussions
- Volunteers consistently

Interacts appropriately with others

Examples:

- Cooperates with others
- Shows empathy and compassion for others
- Respects others' perspectives and differences
- Recognizes how own actions impacts others
- Resolves interpersonal conflicts respectfully
- Takes responsibility for actions and words

Organizes materials

Examples:

- Organizes books, papers, writing utensils, etc.
- Puts coats/shoes, etc. in locker
- Finds missing items without teacher assistance
- Puts materials where they belong
- Is responsible for items that travel between home and school

Manages emotions

Examples:

- Thinks before acts
- Regulates self to be ready to learn
- Manages impulsivity

Self-advocates

Examples:

- Asks for help when needed
- Uses assertive communication
- Takes initiative

Embraces challenges

Examples:

- Perseveres when faced with challenges
- Views mistakes productively
- Has a growth mindset
- Shows resilience

Focuses attention

Examples:

- Stays on task
- Uses time constructively
- Starts and finishes tasks independently
- Uses active listening strategies
