Will the piece of wall art be a focal point, or do you plan to use it as an accent piece? If you want people to walk into the room and immediately notice the wall art, you're going to want to choose a style that's striking. If you're looking for something that will make a wall feel a little less lonely, you should stick to quite pieces that blend into the room's décor.
