- A charge of \$50 will be assessed for any returned check or insufficient-funds non-payment.
- Any account 30 days (or one payment) delinquent may result in the student's removal from enrollment until the account is brought current or acceptable arrangements have been made with the Board of Christian Education.
- All account balances must be paid in full **before** transcripts will be released.
- Any accounts considered "past due" or remaining "delinquent" may be turned over to a professional agency for collection.
- All outstanding tuition and fees from the previous school year must be paid in full in order to continue the re-enrollment process for the 2026-2027 school year.
- This document is understood to be legally binding, and my signature below constitutes my agreement to comply with the collection of all fees due the school for services rendered.

Please read the following prior to signing below:

- ☐ I have prayerfully considered the Re-Enrollment of my child at St. Paul Lutheran School for the upcoming school year. Furthermore, I have carefully and seriously read the Parent & Family Commitment and Financial Obligation information above.
