	<p>Update on EU funding</p> <p>- N/A</p> <p>Update on Buddy work</p> <p>DT: After a review of the materials that Susan pulled together last year, Filipa and I have started some preliminary work on a <a href="#">Global Innovation Fund</a> application (typically \$250,000 - \$2M awards). We have pulled the application questions into a <a href="#">google doc</a> and will start work on them there. Reviewing Susan's materials, I also identified three funders that require a Lol to start the application process: <a href="#">Common Future</a> (Funding range unclear – still worth an Lol); <a href="#">Croatian Institute</a> (Funding range unclear – still worth an Lol) and the <a href="#">Open Society Foundation</a> (\$40,000 - \$2,000,000 ... many in \$100,000 range). Was thinking that we could start a process for repurposing the content of the <a href="#">Wallace Foundation Lol</a> so that it speaks to the goals of each funder? I am happy to start chipping away at this and would share drafts with the group for feedback..</p> <p>Filipa- work on Global Innovation Fund, we shall include work that is being done in the OFN mostly in volunteering basis that is not soft Dev. and could be framed more towards a feasibility study, than an actual deliverable project (as it can become a very big endeavour very easily).</p> <p>Nick's update - Kurt Forbes Prize, our answer has been accepted and Olivia Shutter is one of the Jury... we are on the top 50 short-list.</p> <p>Rachel - <b>Ground Effect</b> reply... we have 3 more weeks to answer (after Kirsten comes back from holiday).</p> <p>Rachel - <b>tender Regional Municipalities</b> in France... Rachel will share the slides of the application with us. ... there might be another regional group of municipalities who could be interested in funding the OFN (they have 2million for developing an Open Source Software).</p> <p>Filipa - advice on the 2 events Filipa has been asked to participate in, as these could be a door to attract funders circle has recommended to check some previous event participation (one in Berlin by Rachel) and also to focus on High level aspects of the network (OFN values is good overview). For transparency reasons advised also to post in Global Community who might want to join the representation of the Boom Festival and for people to mention why they would like to go represent OFN.</p>
