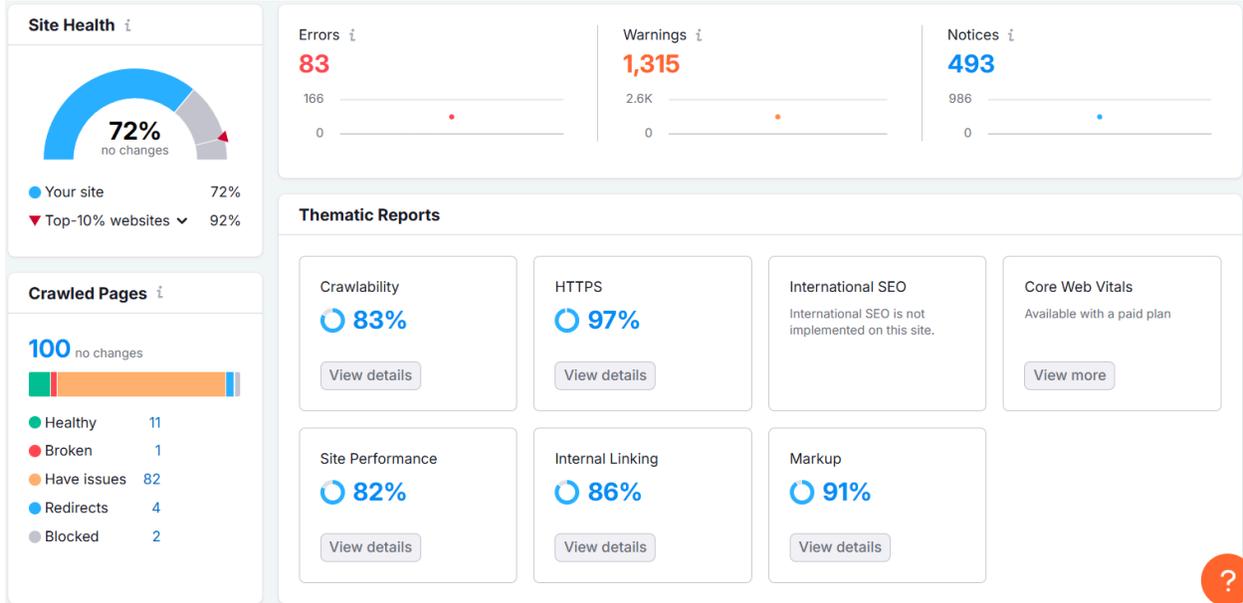

Technical SEO



Crawlability and Indexability

Crawlability is the ability of a search engine to access a web page and crawl its content while indexability refers to the ability of a search engine to analyze the content it crawls to add to its index.

36 pages have been found to have slow page load speed and 1 page has a 404 response code.

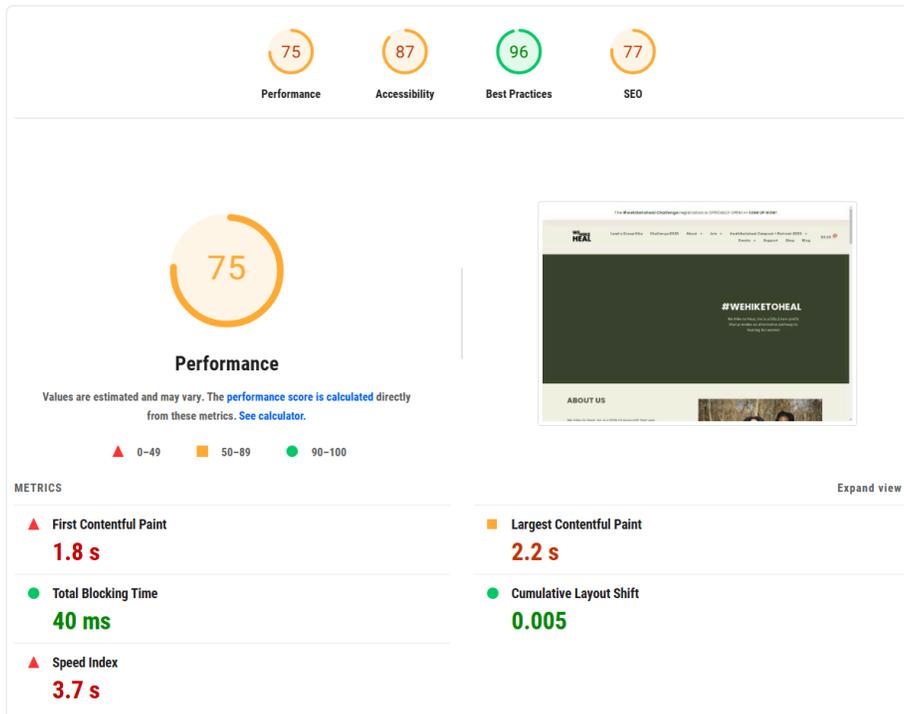
Core Web Vitals

Core Web Vitals are a set of three metrics that measure the speed, interactivity, and visual stability of a webpage. They are a huge ranking factor that can also affect user experience.

Largest Contentful Paint (LCP) is the time it takes for a browser to load the largest block of content on your homepage. This should be *less or equal to 2.5 seconds*.

Total Blocking Time (TBT) is the total amount of time that the main thread of a webpage gets blocked due to long tasks, preventing it from responding to user interactions while processing the load. This should be *less than 200 milliseconds*.

Cumulative Layout Shift (or CLS) is a measure of how much a webpage unexpectedly shifts during its life. This should have a score of *less than 0.1*.



WHTH core web vitals need to be improved. This can be improved by reducing javascript execution time, minifying images, and more. Click here for full [mobile report](#) and [desktop report](#).

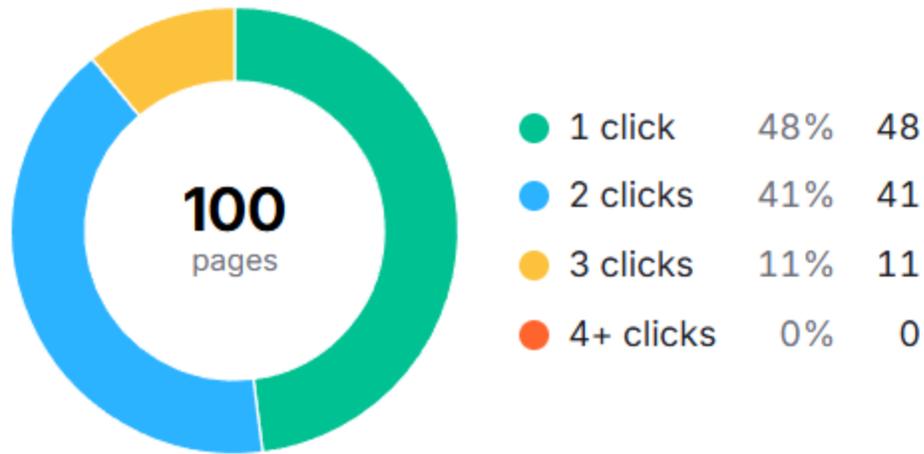
Site Architecture

Crawl Depth

Pages should not be more than 3 clicks deep. Too many pages buried in the architecture signals that there is unimportant or poor content within the site.

WHTH has excellent crawl depth with no pages being more than 3 clicks deep.

Internal Link Distribution

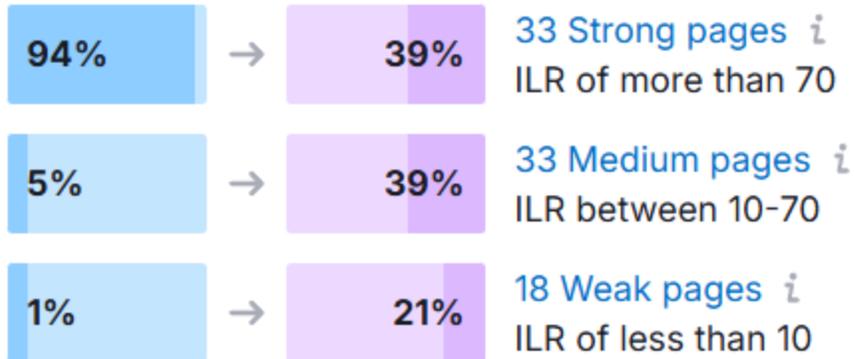
Internal linking tells search engines the relationship of web pages and which pages are the most important. Internal LinkRank (ILR) measures the link juice flow between your website's pages using a 100-point scale (from 0 to 100). If a page is linked by a large number of authoritative pages within your website, it will have a high LinkRank score.

There are 18 pages with weak ILR on the site. It's important to look through these pages and have important pages have more incoming internal links. Top level pages such as the home page should have more links pointing towards it. Have top level pages interlink with lower level pages.

Additionally, 2 pages have been found to have broken internal links and 99 pages have Nofollow attribute internal links. It is recommended to set internal links to Dofollow because Nofollow internal links interfere with link juice flow.

Responsiveness

A responsive website enhances user experience by adapting to different screen sizes, ensuring easy navigation and faster load times. This aligns with Google's mobile-first indexing, leading to better SEO rankings.

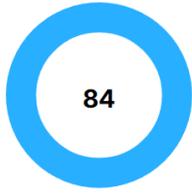
WHTH is optimized for desktop and mobile, but not for tablets.

Structured Data

Structured data is code that helps search engines understand and categorize the content of web pages and improve indexability. This allows search engines to retrieve more informative results for users in the form of rich snippets, FAQ's, and other SERP features.

All pages with a 202 status code have been found to have at least one type of microdata. However, 34 structured data items (event markups) have invalid structured data.

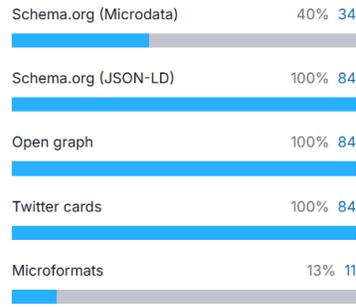
Pages with Markup i



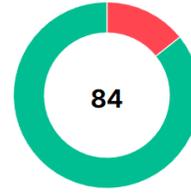

Structured Data by Pages v



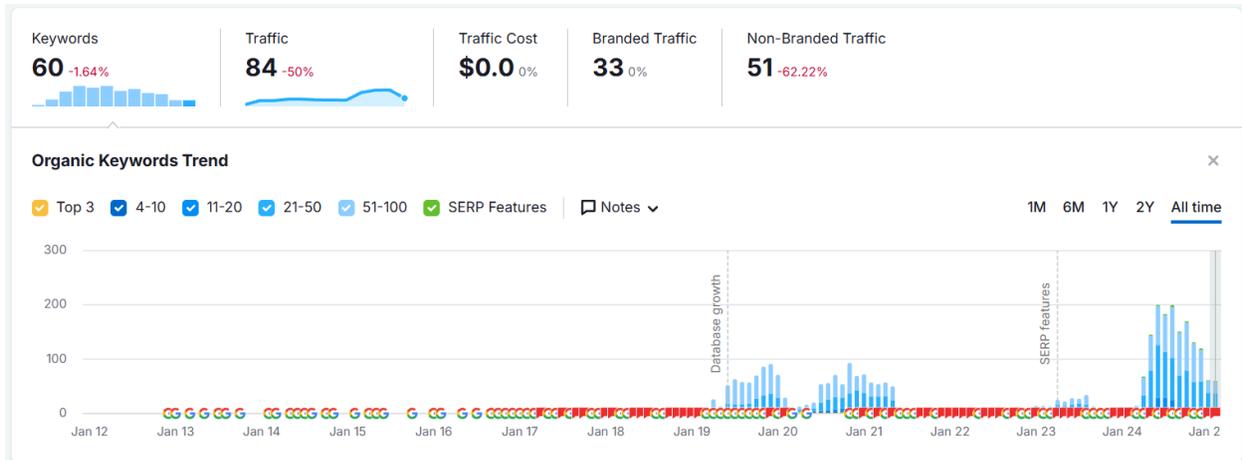

WHTH is currently ranking for 60 keywords, but has experienced a decrease in traffic.

Low-hanging fruit keywords

Keywords currently ranking in positions 2-15. These are the keywords and pages that require the least amount of resources to increase rank and organic traffic. Thus, focusing efforts on low-hanging fruit keywords first is the fastest way to increase rank and organic traffic.

WHTH has 2 low hanging fruit keywords, a branded keyword and the keyword “ladies hiking club fayetteville ga”.

Existing KWs and Clustering Opportunity KWs

Keywords currently ranking from positions 16-50 and positions 51-100, respectively. These keywords and pages can be used to create content hubs. Content hubs help to establish topical authority, a site's perceived credibility about a certain topic.

WDC has 58 keywords ranking in positions 16-50 and 51-100 that could be used to make topic clusters.

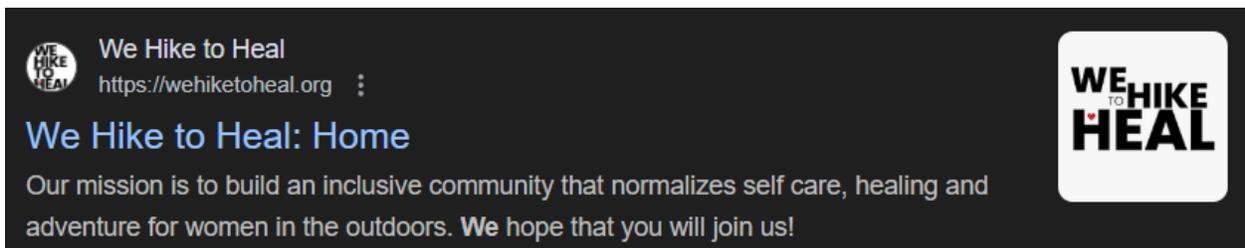
Value Proposition

A good value proposition should have keywords and communicate the intent of the organization and what makes them unique from competitors. A value proposition not only makes it clear to users what they offer, it is also an opportunity to give context to search engines as to what the site is trying to rank for.

The hero section talks about what WHTH offers as an organization. However, this can be improved by including keywords and being more descriptive about what the organization offers. Add CTAs.



Meta Tags



Title tags

Title tags are HTML elements that indicate the title of a web page. They help search engines understand the content of the page and its relevance to a search query. This also serves as the clickable link displayed in the SERP. It gives the user an idea as to what the website is about and influences click-through rate (CTR). Title tags should be between 51-60 characters in length to avoid being cut off in the SERP.

WDC has no missing title tags. However, the title tag could be improved by including keywords and maximizing the character limit so it takes up more space in the SERP. Additionally, make unique title tags for the pages with duplicate title tags.

Meta descriptions

Meta descriptions are another HTML component of web pages. It provides a summary of the contents of the web page, helping both the search engine and the users understand what the page is about. Meta descriptions appear beneath the title tag in the SERP and help persuade users to visit the website. Meta descriptions should be between 150-160 characters.

WHTH has 59 missing meta descriptions. Add meta descriptions to these [pages](#). It is recommended to include the primary and latent semantic indexing (LSI) keywords (keywords that are related to the primary keyword) in the meta description and to maximize the character limit.

Header tags

Header tags are HTML elements that are used to distinguish the headings from the subheadings and the rest of the content. Header tags organize the content of the website in a hierarchical manner. This improves the readability of the content for both search engines and users.

WHTH has 32 missing H1 tags. Assign H1 tags in these [pages](#). Use primary keywords in the header tags. Additionally, make unique H1 tags for the 9 pages with duplicate H1 tags.

Internal Links and Anchor Text

Search engines scan anchor texts because they provide context about the linked page. Hence, it is best to add keywords in the anchor text of links. Having a clear CTA also guides users and increases the likelihood that they will complete a desired action before leaving the site.

Include keywords in the anchor texts of internals. Example: Instead of “Learn More”, use “Learn About WeHikeToHeal”.

Copywriting

Long-form copy provides more opportunities to rank for relevant keywords and gives more context to search engines as to what the business is about.

There is no long-form copy on the site. Create long-form copy in the home page using the primary keyword and LSI keywords. Example: Talk about the struggles of women, how WeHikeToHeal has helped women, etc.

Site Navigation

It is best to have a dedicated page for every topic or keyword that an organization wants to rank for instead of having all the topics in one page. This makes it easier for search engines to determine the intent of each page and its relevance to search queries and allows the website to rank for different terms.

WHTH has a dedicated page for each of their events. However, consider having a static page going through the inclusions of a typical event. Additionally, categorize content pages and separate the blog content from news/announcements.

Content Analysis

Content analysis and strategy is done for *every page and keyword that you want to rank*. For a page to rank, it must match a keyword's search intent, contain better content, and/or possess higher page authority or backlinks in comparison to competitors in the SERP.

Keyword Cannibalization

Keyword cannibalization occurs when you have various blog posts or articles on your site that can rank for the same search query in Google. This happens when multiple pages on a site target the same keyword(s) and serve the same purpose. As a result, search engines can't discern which content to rank higher. You're "cannibalizing" your results by splitting CTR, links, content, and conversions between two pages that should be one.

WHTH does not have cannibalized keywords. Nevertheless, keyword cannibalization can be fixed by merging the content, using canonical tags, deindexing one page, or deoptimizing cannibal pages.

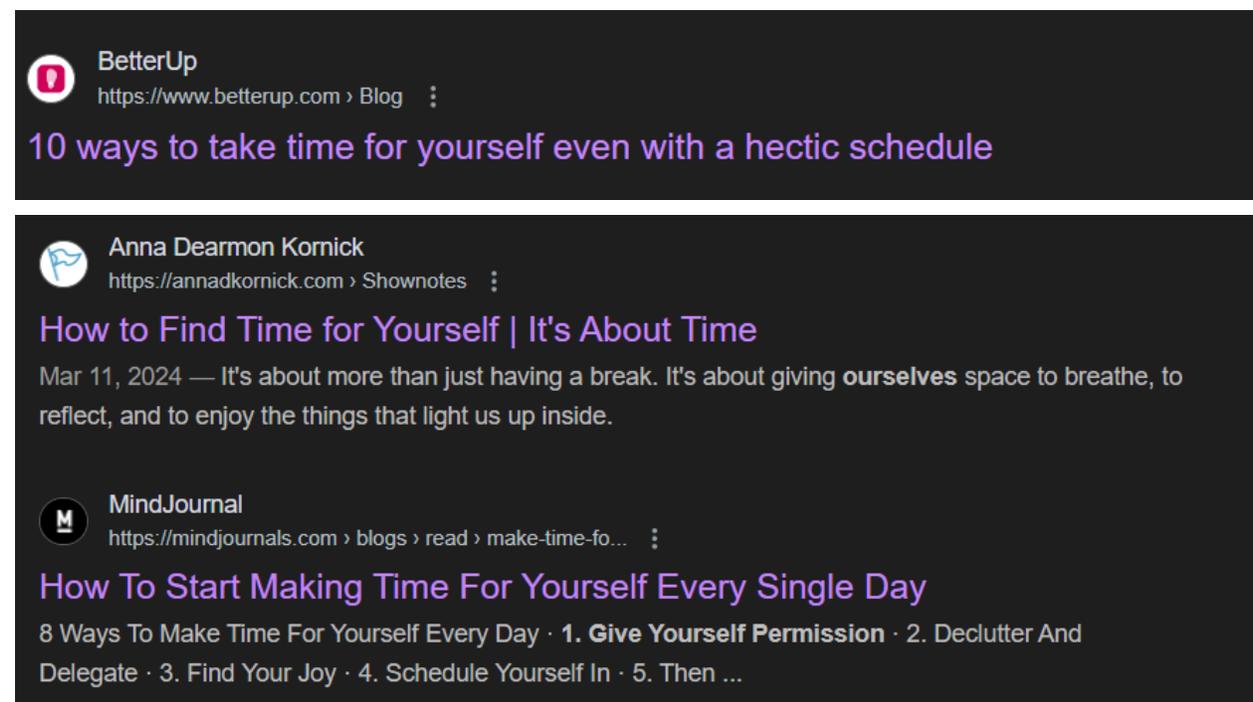

Content Quality

Search Intent

For a page to rank, it must match what the user is looking for. The pages currently ranking in the first page of the SERP contain lists or a step-by-step process about the topic.

WHTH has the same type of content as the pages ranking in the first page. This indicates that the content matches with the search intent.

Readability

Readability is important for SEO because clear, easy-to-understand content keeps users engaged, reduces bounce rates, and helps search engines rank your pages higher.

The content has good structure. It uses short paragraphs, bullet points, and simple language. However, make sure to properly assign header tags to help search engines understand the hierarchy of the content.

Content Length

Generally, long-form content tends to be ranked higher because it increases dwell time, attracts more backlinks, and ranks for a wider range of keywords. Take note that content length still depends on search intent and SERP competition.

On average, the top 3 pages for the keyword “finding time for yourself” have an average word count of 2300. Aim to have a word count around this range.

Multimedia

Multimedia enhances user engagement, and increases the likelihood of earning backlinks and showing up as rich snippets or featured results in the SERP.

There is only one image per article. Consider adding more multimedia content in the pages.

Internal and External Linking

Internal linking helps to keep users on the site and sends signals to Google that you provide a breadth of information about a certain topic.

WHTH has no internal linking in the content. Organize content into topic clusters. Topic clusters should have cluster pages that link up to a pillar page and vice versa. Consider adding in a table of contents that is anchored to different sections of the page and a read also section that links to other content pages in the site.

Outbound external links show Google that you care about quality and that you're producing fair, well-researched content. They are important for SEO because they help to build trust and authority with your audience by showing them that you have sources for your information.

WHTH has no external links in the content pointing to high domain authority sites.

Keyword Optimization

Primary KW should be in the URL, Title Tag, Meta Description, H1 Tag, first sentence, and last sentence of each page.

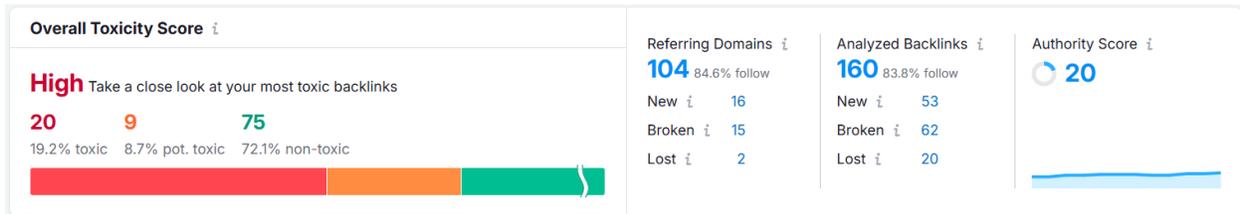
The primary keyword is present in the URL, Title Tag, Meta Description, H1 Tag, and in the first paragraph.

Latent Semantic Indexing (LSI) keywords are conceptually related terms that search engines use to deeply understand the content on a webpage.

The content uses related keywords such as: self-care, well-being, calm, peace, mindfulness, breaks, and etc.

WHTH has 160 backlinks, 84% of which are dofollow, and 104 referring domains.

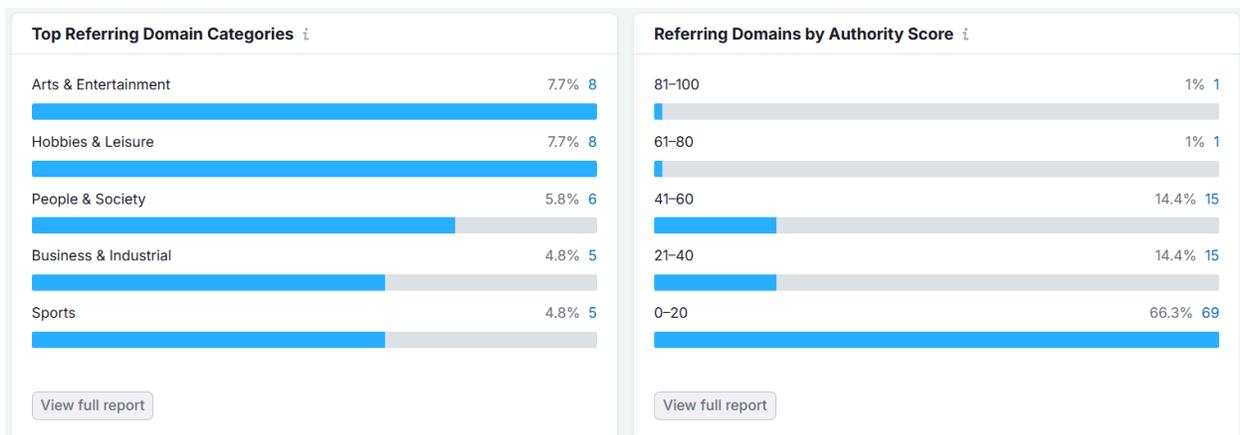
Toxic Links

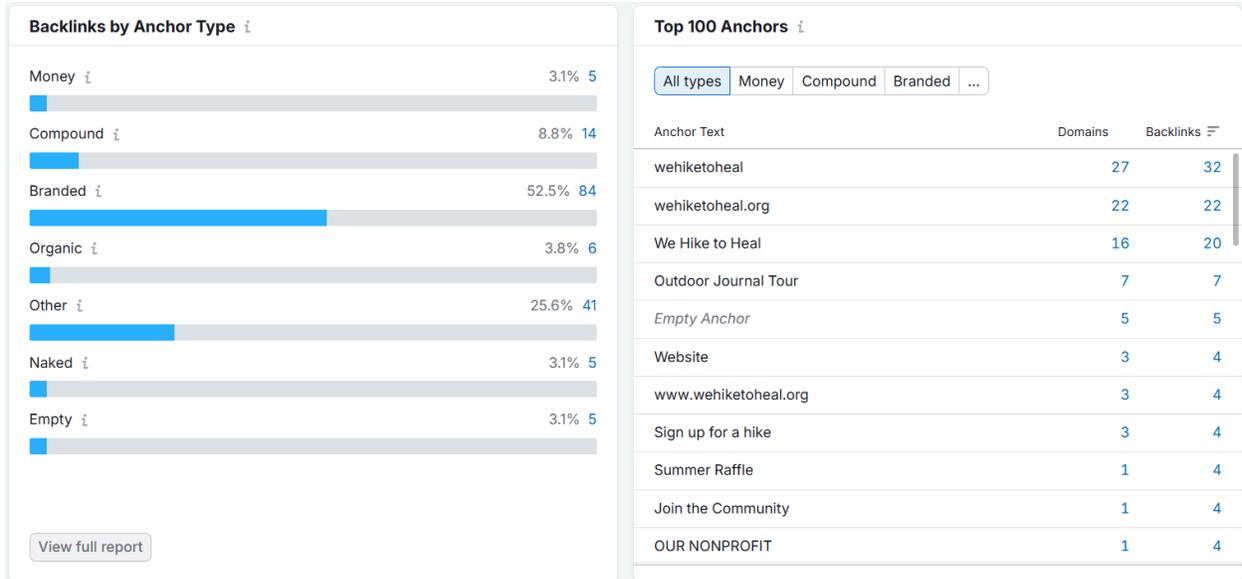
Toxic links are links that have the potential to harm a website's ability to rank.

There are 20 toxic links for WHTH, most coming from low-quality directories. Reach out to owners of these sites to remove these links. Disavow links as a last resort.

Referring Domains and Anchor Text

The majority of referring domains have an authority score of 0-20 and are relevant to WHTH. Anchor texts are varied. These are all signs of white hat link building.





Domain Authority

Domain Authority is a metric that estimates how likely a website is to appear in the SERP in comparison to competitors. The closer the authority score is to 100, the more likely it is to appear and rank higher in the SERP.

WHTH has an authority score of 20. Domain authority can primarily be improved by building a solid backlink profile and by improving the site structure and producing valuable content or increasing topical authority, which is authority gained from being known as an expert in one's niche.

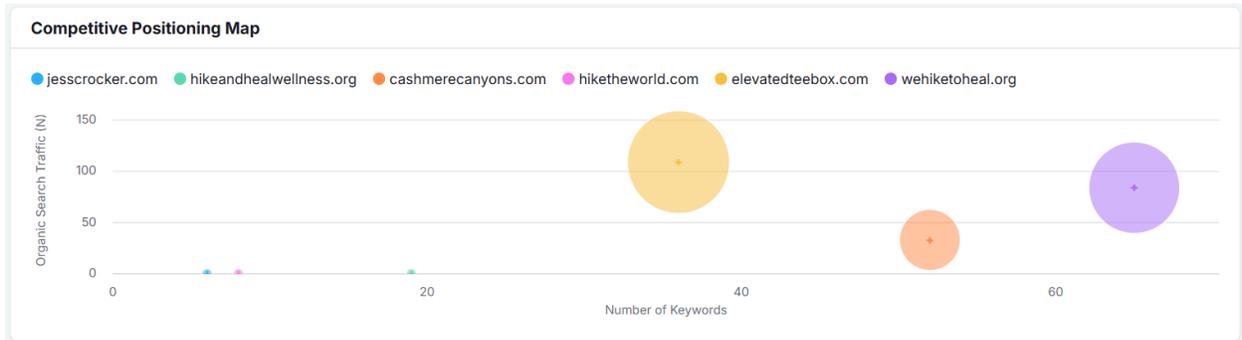

WHTH is ranking for more keywords than its competitors and has nearly the same visibility as one of its competitors.

A backlink gap analysis reveals websites that link to your competitors but not to you, helping you acquire quality backlinks and strengthen domain authority.

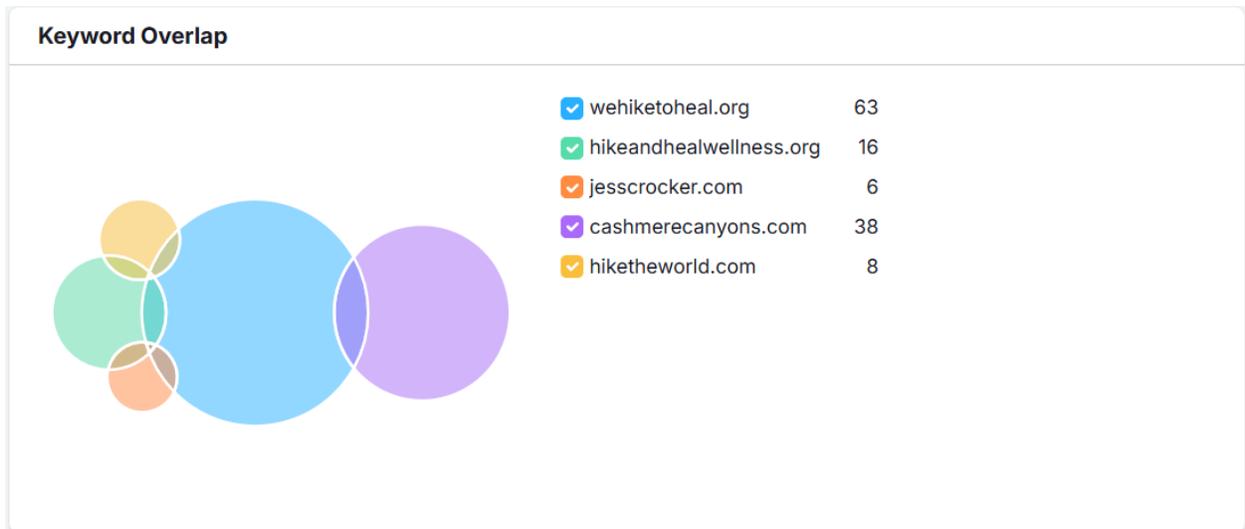

Summary

Technical SEO

What's Done Right: The website has excellent crawl depth and is optimized for desktop and mobile. Additionally, structured data is present on all pages with a 202 status code.

What Needs Improvement: Core Web Vitals and site speed need improvement. There were broken internal links, nofollow internal links, and a 404 status code found in the site. Internal linking structure needs improvement. The site is not fully optimized for tablets, and some structured data items contain errors.

How to Improve: Reduce JavaScript execution time, optimize images, and minify code to improve Core Web Vitals. Fix broken links, update nofollow internal links to dofollow where applicable, and optimize structured data for accuracy. Have more incoming internal links to important pages such as the home page. Ensure the site adapts properly to tablet screens.

Keyword Analysis

What's Done Right: The site ranks for 60 keywords and has identified two low-hanging fruit keywords that can be targeted for quick ranking improvements. There is also an opportunity to create content hubs using 58 ranking keywords.

What Needs Improvement: Traffic has decreased, and the number of ranking keywords is relatively low. Content clusters have not yet been created to improve topical authority.

How to Improve: Prioritize optimizing content for low-hanging fruit keywords to boost rankings quickly. Develop content clusters by grouping related topics and interlinking them to establish authority.

On-Page SEO

What's Done Right: The hero section talks about what WHTH offers as an organization and there are no missing title tags. Moreover, WHTH has a dedicated page for each of their events.

What Needs Improvement: The hero section lacks keywords and CTAs. There are pages with missing meta descriptions, and missing and/or duplicate H1 tags. There are meta tags with no keywords. The home page has no long-form content. Internal link anchor texts are vague and do not use keywords.

How to Improve: Add relevant keywords and CTAs to the hero section. Optimize meta tags by including primary keywords and using the full character limit. Create keyword-optimized meta descriptions, H1 tags, and anchor texts. Implement long-form content on key pages, improve navigation by separating blog content from news/announcements, and use keywords in the anchor texts of internal links.

Content Analysis

What's Done Right: The site's content aligns well with search intent, has good readability, and includes LSI keywords. There are no issues with keyword cannibalization.

What Needs Improvement: Content pages have little to no multimedia, internal links, and external links. Content length is shorter than top-ranking competitors.

How to Improve: Expand articles to match the average word count of top-ranking pages. Incorporate additional images, videos, and/or infographics to improve engagement. Use internal links to create topic clusters and add external links to authoritative sources for credibility.

Competitive Analysis

What's Done Right: WHTH has a natural link profile. WHTH has an authority score of 20 and has good visibility in comparison to competitors.

What Needs Improvement: There are toxic backlinks coming from low-quality directories that could harm rankings. The number of backlinks and referring domains can be increased.

How to Improve: Reach out to site owners to remove toxic backlinks and disavow harmful links as a last resort. Focus on building high-quality backlinks from authoritative websites through guest posting and other link building strategies.
