

[Obsidian.md](#) is a notetaking app with a JavaScript plugin API somewhat similar to the one found in Google Chrome.

I would like an Obsidian plugin that generates a list of links to Obsidian notes that match criteria I specify.

For example, I have a lot of notes whose titles begin with an “=” character. I would like to generate a list of all these notes (for my [highlights](#) page).

I will want to create many lists of notes in many separate notes, matching various queries.

## Requirements:

- Generate a list of notes that match following criteria:
  - Note title (file name) CONTAINS / STARTS WITH / ENDS WITH string
- The list of notes should have following sort options:
  - Alphabetical
  - Modified time (most to least recent)
- The list should update automatically when new matches are found.
  - The update does not need to happen instantly. Anytime within 10 minutes of a new match is fine.
    - (I’m not sure about the options for implementing automatic updates. I imagine there may be a significant performance tradeoff for large note repositories: I say take an approach that will scale to very large repos without a performance hit.)
  - It should be easy to manually trigger all lists to update via the Obsidian command window.
- The list should be written as markdown into the Obsidian text files (i.e. if I open the text file in an editor, it should contain the list info, not some placeholder).

## Illustration of expected behaviour:

Thanks for your work on this.

Please could you spend up to 3 more hours fixing the following issues?

- Link output
  - Expected behaviour: output should be list of note titles surrounded by square brackets, per the Obsidian Wikilink format.
  - Actual behaviour: output is markdown link format.
- Updating lists
  - Expected behaviour: if I run the command twice on a single note, it should replace the existing list.
  - Actual behaviour: the command just appends a second list beneath the first one.
- Add support for a "CONTAINS tag" match condition
  - Information on Obsidian tags:

- Update the README.md file with:
