The revised HGD vision statement was written as follows: <i>The Human Growth and Development program, as one aspect of the district's health curriculum, aims to create an inclusive space where students will gain age-appropriate, medically-accurate, and relevant information. Students will be developing and utilizing decision making skills while affirming others and respecting boundaries.</i> • The advisory committee established the criteria that would be used by the District's Health Steering Committee to review and select instructional resources by using a resource from the Department of Public Instruction's Human Growth and Development resource guide. • The advisory committee previewed the curricular resources and materials that would be reviewed by the Health Steering Committee in May in accordance with the HGD Vision and guidance established by the advisory committee.
