MEMORANDUM FOR Garinger High School JROTC Cadets

SUBJECT: JROTC Contract

1. All cadets participating in the Garinger High School JROTC program will follow the following rules IAW AR 145-2 and AR 670-1. Failure to adhere to any of the rules stipulated could ultimately result in release from the JROTC program.
2. Rules.
 - a. Adhere to the uniform and appearance standards set forth in Cadet Command Regulation 145-2 and Army Regulation 670-1.
 - b. Class A/B uniform must be worn throughout the school day specified by the JROTC Instructor. (Cadets who have an excused absence in listed Power School on the day of inspection are allowed a make-up inspection the following Monday.)
 - c. Set the example by following the Cadet Creed
 - d. Complete all assigned JROTC work.
 - e. Cadet must be active in the JROTC Cadet Corps; by participating in two or more JROTC sponsored events.
 - f. Respect your fellow cadets
 - g. Cadet must turn-in clean uniform at the end of the school year with the cleaners tag when designated by the JROTC Instructor. If a cadet does not turn in uniform, cadets could be charged for military uniform.
 - h. Cadets must be familiar with the chain of command.
 - i. Always do your best...always!
3. As cadets, we represent Garinger High School JROTC, we must always behave and present a professional appearance at all times.
