

2018-2019 GRADUATE PROGRAM REVIEW COMMITTEE (GPRC) CHARGE

The UNLV Graduate Program Review Committee (GPRC) works hand-in-glove with the Faculty Senate to ensure rigorous and appropriate review of graduate programs.

This committee meets on an ad-hoc basis and at least one member is assigned to the team for each graduate program being reviewed.

Responsibilities include:

- Ensuring robust opportunities for input from graduate faculty, graduate students, other teaching and support faculty/staff, and alumni.
- Gathering and assessing key metrics in the graduate program review process.
- Integrating the Graduate College in the review process, and ensuring that the Graduate Dean receives both the department materials and the final program assessment, and is engaged in the review process as appropriate.
- Provide transparency about which programs are being reviewed each year, which were reviewed in the previous year, and which graduate programs are up for review in the next academic year.
- Additional projects and engagement at the will of the Committee and as need arises.

Graduate College coordination:

- Dr. Emily Lin, Associate Dean: Advises on policies and best practices; ensures quality, excellence, and rigor; interacts with outside reviewers; represents the Dean in meetings.
- Dr. Kate Korgan, Dean: Reviews program review documents and final reports; interacts with outside reviewers; makes post-review recommendations.
- Leslie Hunter, Executive Assistant to Dean: Assist with room reservations; help with Google Sites (to ensure agendas and minutes are posted); provide guidance as needed.
