

Hudson Valley Council Participant Payment Schedule

2021 National Scout Jamboree

The total fee for a contingent participant (adult or youth) is estimated at \$2,100. Price is subject to review and may change.

Payment Plan

The Hudson Valley Council is pleased to offer a payment plan to help make the participant fee as manageable as possible. The schedule is as follows:

- Deposit due with approved application: \$300
- February 1, 2020: \$300
- April 1, 2020: \$300
- June 1, 2020: \$300
- August 1, 2020: \$300
- September 1, 2020: \$300
- November 1, 2020: \$300

Due to the required financial obligations and commitments, all youth participants must be up-to-date according to the payment schedule or risk their Jamboree application will be placed on the waiting list.

Any payments due prior to receiving a participant's application will be due when the application is approved. In short, at the time you sign up you must pay to become current with the payment schedule upon the acceptance of your application.

Refund Policy

Because the council contracts for services and goods on behalf of the National Jamboree contingent participants, *all paid funds are non-refundable, but are transferable to a replacement participant.*

For any reason and at any time, in the event that a participant cannot attend the Jamboree, the replacement procedure will begin with the following procedure.

1. The head of the waiting list will be contacted about the vacancy.
2. The head of the waiting list pays the exiting participant family directly for the previously paid funds and council for any outstanding balance on the payment schedule.
3. When both transactions are complete, the head of the waiting list comes off and replaces the exiting participant.
4. If the head of the waiting list declines the offer to accept the vacancy, the scout moves to the bottom of the waiting list and the process repeats.
5. If there is no waiting list, or all scouts on the waiting list decline the vacancy, the exiting participant is responsible for securing a replacement in order to recoup their paid funds.
