Window Panes for Poetry

Directions: Using the six window panes and any surrounding white space, illustrate the imagery in the poem and match it to the lines of the poem.

- 1. Decide which lines will go together. The entire poem must be rewritten within the panes. Write those lines (neatly!) in or near the panes.
- 2. Illustrate the imagery those lines describe. You should do this will block figures, symbols, and/or colors. Your images should attempt to illustrate metaphors or tone.
- 3. If you haven't yet, add color. This should be suitable for classroom display.

Grading:

- 1. The entire poem is represented.
- 2. Images demonstrate the poem's tone and message.
- 3. The writing is neat and legible.
- 4. Color is used appropriately and reflects the poem's tone.
