

Below is a summary from before I began writing this;

March 23-March 28th

23: Idea for creating a novelty coin came up in my head, this was due to me joking around with friends about my own coin, I decided to make it a reality.

24: Forked smallchange source, began to change variables

25: Finished variables, began to (try) to compile, I encountered numerous compilation errors, decided to rest on it for the the night.

26: Try to compile (again), succeed! Created genesis block, recompiled, initial release of coin. After the release, I noticed an error with blocks not paying out rewards... I found a rogue function in smallchange's source to prevent rewards for the first 3 days. Fixed this, and recompiled.

27: REALLY surprised at the amount of interest in my coin. Even though I've only got a few responses, I'm very happy someone decided to mine it, just for fun.

28: Someone was pointing a 3.5 Mh/s rig my way.. wow. Perhaps someone see's value in my novelty coin?

Begin current updates:

29th: Decide to start writing journal like document on the development and updates of my coin. I'm surprised at the net hashrate, as I'm not currently mining. It seems someone else is. The block explorer is up to block 849: that means ~849000 coins have been generated of the 600000000 total. Perhaps I will update the art in the qt wallet. That would mean more MS Paint graphics, but perhaps..

30th: I upgraded the way the pool server works, no longer will it go through a redirect file. This means icecube45pool.zapto.org brings you strait to the pool. I just saw the net hasrate go up to 1.5 mh/s, it's gone now, but still amazing. A new user called xyq001357 was mining at the pool. Cool that its not just me any more. The current block is 1093: ~1093000 coins paid out.
