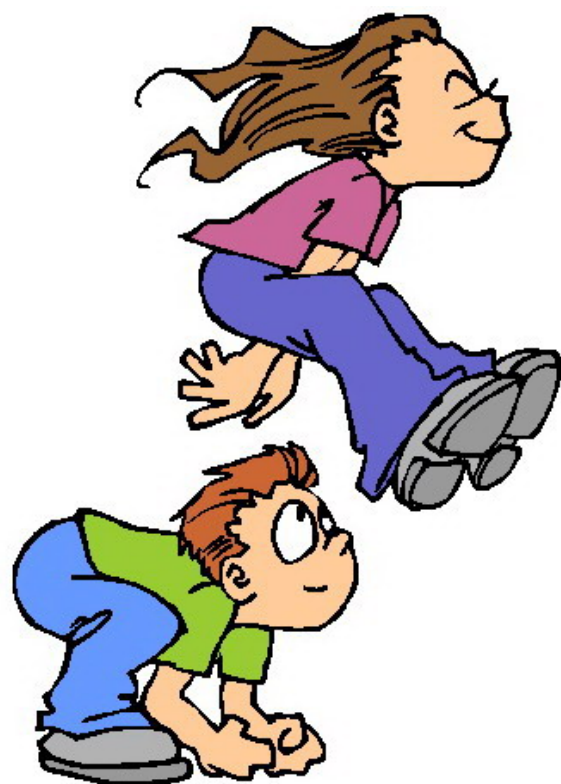
word	definition	sentence
