Processing Photos in Photoshop

- 1. Create photo folder in progress folder with the name of the assigned photos or 'extra'
- 2. Cut/Paste photos from memory card into the appropriate folder in the progress folder
- 3. Open bridge & do 1st deletes
- 4. Rename files beginning with 1 and having 3 digits and a name like —murphygrunge So a finished name example would be 024-murphygrunge14 The 14 at the end stands for the year the photo was taken. It's up to you if you want to include something like that.
- 5. Open photo (s) you want to process in photoshop
- 6. Pull guides from the side rulers representing where you would like to crop your 8x10 Refer to step 9 below.
- 7. Possible adjustments you might make
 - a. Adjustment layer levels
 - b. Adjustment layer curves
 - c. Adjustment layer hue/saturuation for saturation
 - d. Adjustment layer convert to black & white
 - e. If your image needs sharpening Filter/sharpen or unsharp mask or smart sharpen
 - i. Duplicate background layer, Filter/Other/Highpass, layer blending mode/overlay
- 8. Save as psd WITHOUT CROP
- 9. Crop at 8x10 300ppi
 - a. Experiment & pull crop tool
 - b. Pull guides to line up with all 4 sides of the crop
 - c. Hit ESC key
 - d. Ctrl S
 - e. Pull crop again & hit enter
 - f. SAVE AS and choose JPG
 - g. Keep same name but add -8x10 at the end of the name. ex: 024-murphygrunge14-8x10.jpg
 - h. Hit enter & choose 12 quality
 - i. Save in TO BE GRADED
 - j. Close without saving 8x10 over the top of your original
