## 2026 Fire School

FNRL Fire School will be held at Camp Tadmor on April 1-3. Fire School is a joint effort between FNRL, the Oregon Department of Forestry, FNRL member schools, and various other agencies and groups. The cost is \$125 per person for FNRL members and \$140 per person for non-member schools. This includes the clean-up by the camp hosts. The camp will start at 4:00 PM on Wednesday with registration and finish after lunch on Friday. **We need the number of participants from each school by March 6<sup>th</sup> 2026.**

### CABIN POLICY
