### Organizing Mutual Aid in Your Community

Solidarity Not Charity: Mutual Aid & How to Organize in the Age of Coronavirus [Video] As lockdowns and layoffs sweep the U.S., mutual aid groups are forming to protect and provide for the vulnerable, including the elderly, incarcerated, undocumented and unhoused.
