Printing the maps

- Most of the coloring maps below have an accompanying timeline which should be printed on the back of the map.
- My college has a printer that automatically does 2-sided printing on 11x17 inch paper, however, older printers will likely require that you print double-sided manually.
- If you would prefer that I send you a packet with maps that already are printed with timelines on the back, please send me a message and provide me with an address.
- Links to coloring guides are included on the previous page. These guides are based on the Crayola Color Pencil 50 pack. The color guides are not strict, but it is useful to have students use the same color to aid with class discussion. Also, without guides many students choose colors that make comprehension difficult.
