

9th-12th Grade Supply List

Students will be changing classes and will have a cubby/locker. We suggest they set up a system to go from class to class that will work best for them. Here are 2 suggestions we feel will work but the student is not limited to these suggestions:

- Use a Trapper Keeper Style Multi-subject Binder with 4 subject Dividers-Language Arts, Math, History, Bible (This will be great to help the child that needs everything in one place.) If they choose this option they will also need a separate 1 ½ in 3-ring Binder with pockets for Latin.
- OR they can use (5) Individual 1 ½ in 3-ring Binders with pockets for each different subject (Language Arts, Math, History, Bible, Latin) each subject will need Dividers (This option will be great for the child that needs to keep each subject separate. This option might make the bookbag heavier when taking homework home but it might not be so cumbersome when going from class to class.)
- Chromebook/laptop (one per family)
- Colored Pencils
- Pencils
- Grading Pen (any color except black)
- Pouch for supplies (optional)
- Protractor
- Graph Paper (Math)
- College-ruled Notebook Paper
- Pack white copy paper
- Small Dry Erase Board (as thin as possible)
- Dry Erase Markers

- Composition Notebook (Science)
- (3) 1 ½ in. 3-ring Binder with pockets
- (2) Pack of Dividers
- Index Cards-Replenish throughout year
- Bible-ESV (English Standard Version)
- 4 Book covers-at least one jumbo
- Flash Drive (optional if using personal computer for workdays)
- Bookbag
- Planner-any style (monthly/weekly)
- Scientific Calculator-Algebra I & Geometry-You may choose a graphing calculator (TI-83 or TI-84 any edition) or a non-graphing scientific calculator (The graphing features of the calculator will not be used until later years)
- Algebra II-You must have a graphing calculator (TI-83 or TI-84)
