The Dixie State Symbolism Act of 2019

Whereas, the state of Dixie should symbolize more objects with this great state. Whereas, the symbology of Dixie should represent its people's values as closely as possible.

Be it enacted by the Assembly of The State of Dixie

Section 1 - Short Name

A. This act shall be referred to as the "The Dixie State Symbolism Act of 2019".

Section 2 - The Dixie Flag

- A. Section 2 Article B of <u>B.002: State Symbols Act</u> is amended as follows: The Flag of the Southern State shall hereby be this flag. The flag of Dixie shall hereby be officially displayed as this flag.
 - a. The <u>state</u> flag shall be flown from all government office buildings belonging to the Southern State over all local, state and federal buildings within the boundaries of the state of Dixie.
 - b. <u>The Dixie Flag shall be of a blue flag to symbolize our states vigilance</u>, perseverance & justice. A white cross over the blue background to symbolize our religious past. There shall be a center circle in the middle, containing eight stars, each representing one of the eight provinces that make up our state. Each star shall point towards the center fleur-de-lis to symbolize our state's heritage and unity.

Section 3 - The State Symbols

- A. Section 2 Article D of <u>B.002</u>: <u>State Symbols Act</u> is amended as follows: The official flower of the southern state shall be the <u>Magnolia grandiflora</u>, also known as the <u>Magnolia Iris hexagona</u>, commonly known as the Louisiana Iris.
- B. The official state fruit shall hereby be *Citrus sinensis*, commonly known as the orange.
- C. The official state animal shall hereby be *Puma concolor*, commonly known as the cougar or mountain lion.
- D. The official state marine mammal shall be *Tursiops truncatus*, commonly known as the Atlantic bottlenose dolphin.
- E. The official state tree shall be Carya illinoinensis, commonly known as the Pecan Tree.

Section 4 - Enactment

- A. This act shall go into effect immediately after it is signed into law
- B. If any portion of this act is struck down, the rest of the act shall still be in effect
