Dear EES Families,

In the event Franklin County Schools must close for any reason (health or weather related), we may have an NTI (Non-Traditional Instruction) day. These are days where students will be learning from home. Since students will be learning from home, NTI days do not need to be made up. As a district, we may use up to 10 NTI days a year.

You may be wondering how your child will learn during an NTI day. Your child is bringing home an orange folder containing NTI work for days 1-10. Your child will complete only the assignments for the corresponding NTI day. The NTI packets contain assignments for each subject area: Reading, Writing, Math, and Science/Social Studies. There are also packets for enrichment areas (music, PE, and art) as well as guidance/social-emotional. When an NTI day is called, your child will complete each activity assigned for that corresponding day (Day 1, Day 2, etc.) in all content areas, including enrichment classes and guidance. Your child must return the work for that day only when he/she returns to school. **Students will have five days to return NTI work or will be counted absent for that NTI day.**

If your NTI folder is ever misplaced, assignments will be posted on the EES website. If you have questions or need assistance, please contact your child's teacher. Teachers will be available for questions/assistance throughout each NTI day. They will contact you to let you know when they will be available.
